

INTERNATIONAL ETCHELLS CLASS PRE-WORLDS (10-12 SEPTEMBER 2022) & WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP (18-24 SEPTEMBER 2022)



Registration tips - get ready NOW!

- 1 At registration you will need to provide a copy of your national sailing authority's International Etchells **Measurement Certificate** showing the boat's ownership details.
- 2 Each crew member must be a **member of the IECA**. Jan Ford, Class secretary at <u>secretary@etchellsukfleet.co.uk</u> can effect membership
- 3 If you are chartering or borrowing a boat, **write to the OA** at secretary@etchellsukfleet.co.uk listing your own sail number including country code and the hull number of the charter/borrowed boat. The OA should reply approving. (NOR 17.1)
- 4 If you own the hull you are racing, but using a different sail number, **inform the OA** at <u>secretary@etchellsukfleet.co.uk</u> of the sail and hull numbers, and sail country code. Approval is not required (NOR 1.10)
- 5 If you do not own a boat, and the skipper is aged 29 or younger at 1st January 2022, you are a Guest Skipper and may enter the Worlds. No special approval is required.
- 6 Please ensure you and your crew each have a **World Sailing ID** and that you have included these **details on yachtscoring** along with your email addresses and mobile numbers. You will be invited to join a Telegram (or equivalent) group before racing starts.
- 7 **Measurement Forms**. These will be available at registration at the Cowes Yacht Haven from and need to be completed with Measurer's signatures verifying compliance.
