### I. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

### 2. ELIGIBILITY

2.1 The event is open to all monohull boats and multihull boats who are members of MRMSA.

# 3. ENTRY PROCEDURES & FEES

- 3.1 Eligible boats may enter completing the online entry form at: https://yachtscoring.com
- 3.2 The deadline to register is October 31, 2022.
- 3.3 Entry fee is \$10.00 per boat paybale via Yacht Scoring.
- 3.4 Yachts may participate in the following classes:

i. Asymmetrical Spinnaker ii. Symmetrical S

ii. Symmetrical Spinnaker

iii. Non-spinnaker

iv. Multihull

v. Kiteboard

vi. Kayak vii. Paddleboard

## 4. SCHEDULE

4.1. The racing window opens Midnight on 5/1/22 and closes Midnight on Halloween 10/31/22.

# 5. RACING

- 5.1. The race course start and finish:

  Mark Designations will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.
- 5.2. Clockwise or counterclockwise it's up to you.

#### 6. SCORING

- 6.1. All classes will be scored using the Time-on-Distance method.
- 6.2. One boat from each class shall be deemed the winner of that class using the fastest corrected time around Fishers Island.
- 6.3. The boat with the fastest elapsed time around Fishers Island shall be deemed to be the overall "line honors" winner.
- 6.4. All entrants will be required to complete a log form and submit it to the Race Committee upon completion of the race course. This form may be photographed/scanned and emailed to <a href="mailto:mudhead@mudhead.org">mudhead@mudhead.org</a>. Only one (I) log may be submitted per entry. Numerous attempts are encouraged.
