1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing and the VX ONE Class rules (www.vxone.org).
- 1.2. The Racing Rules may be altered by the regatta sailing instructions.
- 1.3. The prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US Sailing) will apply except the prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and 63.4. A complete list of US Sailing Prescriptions is available on the US Sailing website.
- 1.4. Part B of the Class rules may be modified for this event.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. The regatta is open to all members of the VX One Class Association. All boats and sails may be inspected for compliance with the Class Rules (www.vxone.org).

3. **FEES**

3.1. The entry registration and fee of \$100.00 shall be completed by September 19, 2015.Registration and other information can be found at www.vxone.org

4. SCHEDULE

4.1. 6 races will be attempted for the Championship, and three completed races will constitute a series.

4.2. **Daily Schedule:**

1300 - Tune-up clinic on land

1400 - Tune-up clinic on water/Practice race

Saturday, September 19, 2015

0800 - 0900 Registration

0900 - 0915 Skippers Meeting

1055 - Warning Signal for first race of the day; additional races will follow. Class meeting/roundtable following racing.

1800 Class Dinner

Sunday, September 20, 2015

0955 - Warning Signal for first race of the day; additional races will follow.

1300 - No race will start after this time.

1500 – Awards Ceremony

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND VENUE

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions will be available at the registration desk.
- 5.2. Races will be sailed on Lake Michigan or Lake Macatawa depending on weather conditions.

6. **SCORING**

6.1. The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

When fewer than 6 races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her races scores with none excluded. This changes RRS A2. When 6 or more races are completed, a boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

7. PRIZES

- 7.1. Trophies will be awarded for the first five places. Other awards may be given.
- 8. Housing will be provided in Club Members homes
