Notice of Race Amendment 1

1. PROCESS FOR REGISTERING

- 1.1. To fully register for this event, there are TWO primary steps for singlehanded entries:
 - The SKIPPER registers the BOAT and pays the entry fee
 - Once the BOAT is registered, the SKIPPER enters their information
 - Once the BOAT is registered, the C420 CREW person enters their information
- 1.2. To fully register for this event, there are Four primary steps for doublehanded entries:
 - The SKIPPER registers the BOAT and pays the entry fee
 - Once the BOAT is registered, the SKIPPER enters their information
 - Once BOAT and SKIPPER information is added, skipper adds crew
 - Once the CREW is added, the C420 CREW person enters their information

2. STEP 1: SKIPPER REGISTERS THE BOAT AND PAYS THE ENTRY FEE

- 2.1. To begin the registration process, go to https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=15322
- 2.2. Once there, click on "Online Registration Form"
- 2.3. Create your own unique Login Access Code (write this down)
- 2.4. Enter the following information:
 - Name
 - Date of Birth
 - Address
 - Mobile phone number and cellular service provider
 - Email address
 - Your home yacht club or sailing program
 - US Sailing member number
 - Boat name (enter "none" if no boat name)
 - Boat type (ILCA Laser or C420)
 - Boat length
 - Sailing prefix (if you have one)(such as USA, etc)
 - Sail number
 - Spinnaker color
 - Emergency contact number (typically a parent, legal guardian or family member)
 - Crew number (enter 1 or 2)



- 2.5. At the bottom, select desired racing course you are entering:
 - ILCA Laser (singlehanded)
 - C420 (doublehanded)
- 2.6. At the bottom, select a sub-class to compete in
 - ILCA 6 (singlehanded)
 - C420 (doublehanded)
- 2.7. Click "continue and submit my registration to this event"
- 2.8. On the next page, proceed to the Liability Waiver, entry fees and payment
- 2.9. On the entry fee page, enter the appropriate entry fee for your class
 - \$80 per singlehanded entry
 - \$150 per doublehanded entry
 - Follow the instructions to complete the payment

3. STEP 2: SKIPPER ENTERS THEIR INFORMATION

- 3.1. Once the boat is registered, the skipper needs to re-visit the Yachtscoring event web page
- 3.2. Click on "Crew Corner"
- 3.3. If necessary, enter your email address and Login Access Code
- 3.4. On the following page, most of the skipper's information should automatically appear
- 3.5. Please enter the additional required information, including:
 - Crew position (skipper)
 - World Sailing Status (enter "Group 1")
 - Emergency contact information

4. STEP 3: SKIPPER Adds their Crew

- 4.1. Login to the "Owners Corner" using the same email address and password/passcode you used when registering
- 4.2. Click on "My Crew List" and add your crew name and email address

5. STEP 4: DOUBLEHANDED CREW ENTERS THEIR INFORMATION

- 5.1. Once the boat is registered, the skipper needs to give their crew the boat's login information for the Yachtscoring event web page
- 5.2. On the event main page, the crew member clicks on "Crew Corner"
- 5.3. On the following page, most of the skipper's information should automatically appear
- 5.4. Please enter the additional required information, including:
 - Crew position (select something other than skipper)
 - World Sailing Status (enter "Group 1")
 - Emergency contact information
