RS Elite Class ASW 2023

Special Sailing Instructions additional to ASW SIs **Amended v2**

1. Rules

- 1.1. The RS Elite Class rules will apply
- 1.2. The use of spinnaker is not allowed

2. Communication

- 2.1. The RC will Stand by on VHF channel 12
- 2.2. The RC may also communicate via WhatsApp

3. Schedule :

- 3.1. Racing days are: Monday, May 1st; Tuesday, May 2nd; Wednesday, May 3rd, 2023.
- 3.2. The first warning signal will not be before 10:50

4. Start and Finish Line:

- 4.1. Committee Boat C will be the launch "Whisper" flying an orange flag.
- 4.2. It will be positioned approximately 150m from Dieppe Bay mark.
- 4.3. The start and finish line will be between the orange flag and an inflatable buoy to its port. ~~The finish line will be between the orange flag and a buoy to its starboard~~

5. Scoring

All boat's scores will be:

- 5.1. When fewer than six races have been completed, the total of her race scores.
- 5.2. From six and up to ten races have been completed, the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- 5.3. When 11 and or more races have been completed, the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

6. Description of Marks

- Dieppe Bay - off white round mark in Dieppe Bay (D)
- Windward 1 - white inflatable Budget Marine mark (W1).
- Cat Club - green channel marker south of Cat Club. (CC)
- St Anne's point - green/red/green off St Anne's Point. (STA)
- Bishop - Red, 1st red channel marker off Bishop's reef (BR)
- English Point - white Budget Marine inflatable, approx 200 yds south of English Point (EP)
- **Windward Beach – West of Windward Beach (WB)**

7. Courses

- 7.1. The course to be sailed will be announced by the RC via VHF channel 12 prior to the first warning signal.
- ~~7.2. Boats shall not cross the start or finish line except when starting, manoeuvring to start or finishing.~~
- 7.3. The position of the windward mark will depend on wind direction and its position will be advised by VHF and/or hailing **and may be transmitted via WhatsApp.**
- ~~7.4. The courses will be within Falmouth Harbour.~~
