**NOTE 1  
PROHIBITED AREA**  
(Area to be avoided)

Under the Florida Keys National Marine Sanctuary and Preserve Act, Pub. L. 99-665 and 840, activities that are prohibited are to be avoided by all vessels and means greater than 10 meters in length.

**NOTE 2  
PROHIBITORY AREA**

In Proceedings, Association against Marine Pollution (AMP) large commercial ships that are not on board of the port of Miami or Miami Beach when the area will be severely limited in this study for research. All vessels are advised to monitor electronic logs to include within the area.

**EXTRAORDINARILY SENSITIVE SEA AREA**

The Extrordinarily Sensitive Sea Area (ESSA) is indicated by a dashed green line. It is designated with a green numbered label or by a green numbered label used in conjunction with the line number for other ESSA with which the ESSA overlaps. A ESSA is an environmentally sensitive area where vessels should exercise extreme caution. See U.S. Coast Pilot volumes for information regarding this area.
