NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2021-2024 (RRS) including the prescriptions of US Sailing except as modified by the Sailing Instructions

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Entry is by invitation
- 2.2. Yachts entering the regatta should have a valid PHRF of the Chesapeake rating certificate
- 2.3. Yachts without a certificate may be approved by the Organizing Authority and assigned a PHRF Rating by the Race Committee.
- 2.4. There will be a Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker division offered.
- 2.5. If there are more than 4 J22's registered, they will race as their own class.

3. ENTRY FEES

	Registration Fee
Less than 25'	\$40
25' to 40'	\$50
More than 40'	\$60

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Registration:
 - 4.1.1. Eligible boats may enter by completing the on-line registration form at Yachtscoring.com and paying the required entry fee by 1800 hours on Thursday September 22, 2022.
 - 4.1.2. Registration can also be done in person on Saturday morning subject to a \$50 late registration fee.
- 4.2. Skippers Meeting will be held at 1100 hours under the tent at the Yacht Club
- 4.3. Races will be distance races and use government marks on the Delaware River
- 4.4. The first warning gun will be at 1200 hours
- 4.5. The courses and respective course lengths will be based on the conditions at the time.

- 4.6. Post-Race party. The Club will be hosting its annual “Caribbean Night” party on Saturday night. All racers, family and friends are invited to attend. Tickets for the party are \$45 per person with a cash bar.
- 4.7. Awards Ceremony will be at the beginning of the party or as soon as possible thereafter.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be posted on or before 1800 hours Monday September 19, 2022

6. SCORING

- 6.1.1. PHRF Time on Distance will be used to score all fleets
- 6.1.2. J22's if scored as a separate class will race as one design and not PHRF

7. PRIZES

- 7.1. The fleet will be split into classes based on registrations.
- 7.2. Scratch sheets will be published Saturday morning, September 24, 2022
- 7.3. One trophy will be given for a class of three or less boats
- 7.4. Two trophies for a class of 4 boats
- 7.5. Three trophies for a class of 5 boats or more

8. MOORINGS

- 8.1. Moorings are available at the club for yachts up to 50'
- 8.2. Reservations for moorings should be made directly by email to dockmaster@cycop.com
- 8.3. Mooring rental is \$35 per night.
- 8.4. Yachts may be rafted up two or three to a mooring at the dockmaster's discretion.

9. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, *Decision to Race*. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, or after the regatta.

10. INSURANCE

It is recommended that each participating boat be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$100,000 per event or the equivalent.
