

Sailing Instruction Amendment 1

8. Marks

8.5 For Division D, original turning marks will be an Orange Marlow Tetrahedron with a small orange ball as the offset and the leeward marks will be "green tetrahedrons". The starting mark may be an orange ball. The finishing mark will be a yellow inflatable mark. "Change marks (See SI 10 and 11) will be a green tetrahedron with a small orange ball for the offset".

9. The Start

9.2 The race committee will attempt to broadcast any boat recalled. Division A will broadcast on VHF channel 68. Division B on VHF channel 69. Division C on VHF channel 72 and Division D will broadcast on channel 05. Distance Race division will broadcast on VHF channel 63. Failure to hear, timing of the broadcast, order of the broadcast are not grounds for redress. **"This changes RRS 62.1(a)"**.

14. Time Limits

14.1 The time limit for the first boat to sail a windward/leeward course in accordance with RRS 28.1 is 2 ½ hours. **"The time Limit for the first boat to finish in the Distance Race division is 1500 hours**".

14.2 Boats still racing 30 minutes after the first boat in that division finishes will be scored TLE (Time Limit Expired, see Scoring). **"In the Distance Racing Division, boats failing to finish within 90 minutes of the first boat in that division will be scored TLE"**. This changes RRS35.

15. PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

15.1 Protests and requests for redress, shall be written on US SAILING protest forms (available at the protest desk in the Quarterdeck Room) and delivered there within one hour of the docking of the race committee finish boat for the division involved. Please add "**This modifies RRS 61.2**".

16. SCORING

16.5 ORC will be scored using the 5-Band Rating System.

17. Radio Communications

17.2 A designated observer may report visual signals displayed by the race committee over VHF channel 68 for A Division, VHF channel 69 for B Division, VHF channel 72 for C Division and VHF channel 05 for D Division. **"Distance Race Division will broadcast on VHF channel 63".** Errors or omissions on the part of the designated observer will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1a.
