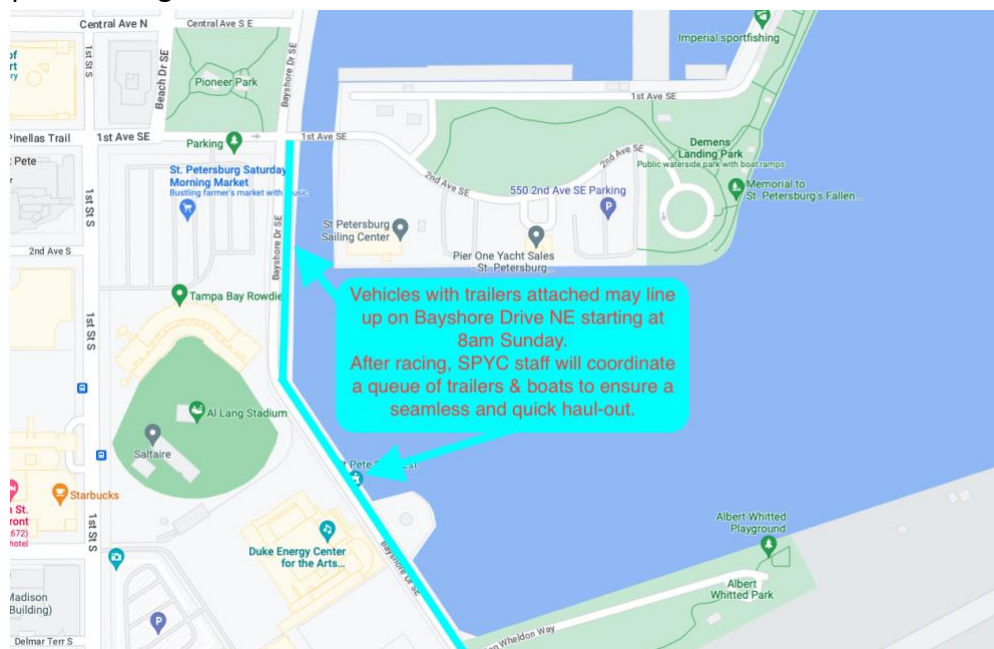


2023 Helly Hansen Sailing World Regatta Series

Sunday Haul Out Plan

- **Elva Rouse Park** - No special instructions, aside from needing boats out of the park Sunday night. We hope you enjoyed the beach launch from the park!
- **Sailing Center** – We have 90+ boats to haul out at the Sailing Center after racing, so all boats able to haul on Monday/Tuesday are strongly encouraged to do so. Check with our staff on available overnight dock space at the Sailing Center.
 - Keelboats needing our hoists will have their vehicles and attached trailers stage on Bayshore Drive (see map below) beginning at 8am. They can remain there while you are out racing. When you return to the Sailing Center after racing, have a crew member to go get your trailer from Bayshore Drive and check in with our staff. We will coordinate your trailer and boat meeting at the hoist. Once boat is on trailer, drive around the building to the wash-down station and drop your rig. With rig down, head back to Bayshore Drive to pack up and head out. All trailers must be off Bayshore Drive by 8pm.
 - Lightnings and Flying Dutchman – During peak haul-out time, vehicles will only be allowed to enter the Sailing Center when your trailer is ready to be hooked up and towed out of the lot. If you need gear from your vehicle in order to pack up your boat, please drop it off in the morning or plan to hang out until the mad rush is over.



- **Main Docks** – Our members will need to return to their slips, so any boats wishing to stay at the docks overnight must coordinate with our dock staff by chatting with them in person, calling 727-822-3227, or hailing them on channel 69. Please do not occupy a slip after racing Sunday without permission.
- **Derby Lane** – All trailers must be removed from Derby Lane by Monday night.
