ON-WATER EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

The event organizers have established emergency procedures to provide help in the event of an on-water emergency, including injury requiring medical assistance. We also have emergency numbers should there be an accident on shore.

- 1. Contact the race committee immediately on your division's race committee VHF channel (VHF channels listed below). If you are unable to contact the race committee, use emergency channel VHF Channel 16.
- 2. Identify your yacht, the nature of the emergency (type of injury, number of people injured), and your yacht's position (Geographical as well as Lat/Long).
- 3. If you are asked to, please cooperate with any race committee, local law enforcement or emergency response personnel.

Please take the time to review these procedures with your crew.
