Arrival

The code for Gate Four will be emailed separately to competitors. The gate is accessible 24 hours a day with the code. This code is also for the pedestrian gate to the left of the main building entrance, although this will be open during the day. All the other pedestrian gates have the code C2013.

Vehicles may access the site through **Gate 4.** We kindly ask that you clear the site as quickly as possible to avoid too much queuing on the road and congestion in the dinghy park. **All vehicles must be parked in the main gravel car park opposite the main building.**

If you are planning to arrive before <u>Friday 1st September</u>, please ensure you check-in at the WPNSA Reception on arrival.

Dinghy Park (see the attached site plan for zones)

Prior to launching, please store your dinghies in the following zones.

J70s Zones 4, 5, 6, 8 & 9

Trailers After launching please store your trailers in Zones 4, 5, 6, 8 & 9

RIB Road Trailers Please put RIB road trailers at the back of the gravel car park, behind the RIB compound.

You may wish to bring a hitch or wheel lock to secure your tailer.

Launching

Launching and recovery will be by the 2 tonne cranes at the crane pier.

Mooring

When launched, boats will be kept in the on the pontoons close to the crane pier.

Support/Coach Vessels & RIB Launching

All coach and support boats must be registered with WPNSA.

To register with the Weymouth and Portland National Sailing Academy please complete an online Event Support Boat Registration Form at https://www.wpnsa.org.uk/event-support-boat-registration-form. The fee is £10 per boat per day and is paid at the WPNSA Reception.

Launching of RIBs from R3 Hard vehicle launching slipway. Please do not leave vehicles or trailers on the road leading up to the slipway as Sunseeker do require access. When launched, support boats will be kept in the on the pontoons close to the crane pier.

Parking

All vehicles are to be parked in the **main gravel car park**, over the road, opposite the main building. Please keep the small car park free for windsurf users to access their slipway. Vehicles are only permitted in the boat park to drop off and pick up boats.

The Cafeteria is open 08:00 – 18:00 during the event.

Bar

Water Refill Points

WPNSA encourages visitors to bring their own reusable drinking containers. There are four water bottle refill points: one in the Cafeteria, one outside the toilet corridor and two at the bottom of the Event Hall ramp. You will see these signs next to the refill points:



Dinghy Park - No Glass or Crockery

For everyone's safety, we kindly ask that no glass or crockery is used in the dinghy park or under the balcony. Many sailors are bare footed or just in dinghy boots walking around, so we want to prevent any cuts from broken glass or crockery.
