## **Amendment 01 to the 2023 Sailing Instructions**

The following instructions are changed to read as follows:

3.4 VHF Channel 71 will be used for all communications. This includes any announcements by the race committee, communication with competitors, and radio Check-Out.

## 18 SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 18.1 A boat shall **Check-In** before racing by passing within hailing distance of the RC signal boat and hailing her check-in information. She shall identify herself by sail number, the racing class she is entered in, and report the number of souls aboard. A check-in isn't complete until it is acknowledged by the RC.

- 18.6 Competitors are cautioned that there are ferries and other commercial traffic in and near Bristol Harbor, and that any interference with such traffic is strictly prohibited. Specifically, any boat that passes close enough to such traffic that either the race or protest committee, or the master of the commercial vessel deems the boat to be too close will be seen as having interfered with that traffic and protested by the race or protest committee for breach of this rule.
