NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 RRS Appendix V will apply.
- 1.3 RRS Appendix T will apply.
- 1.4 Rule 61 will be changed to require boats to notify the Race Committee immediately after finishing of their intent to protest.
- 1.5 Each boat shall carry a radio capable of transmitting and receiving VHF channel 71.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to keelboats and multi-hulls between 19-80 feet LOA with a YRALIS PHRF BASE RATING less than 228.

3 FEES

The entry fee for all classes is \$55. Online entry is required. Completed entries must be received no later than 1200 on November 2nd, entries received after this date will include a \$25 late fee. 4 RACE FORMAT

The regatta will consist of one race, course set around government marks.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Date of race: Saturday, November 4th first warning at 11:00.
- 5.2 Number of races: All classes one race per day.

6 MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall produce a valid PHRF rating certificate. PHRF certificates from other areas will be adjusted to conform to the YRA of LIS. The race committee, based upon best available information, will assign PHRF handicaps for boats not rated by the YRA of LIS.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available not later than 0900 on October 30^{th} at Huguenot Yacht Club and on Yachtscoring.com

8 VENUE and COURSES

- 8.1 Attachment A shows the location of the racing area, with the start at G C "1" NE of Execution Rocks.
- 8.2 The courses for the race will be a course set around government marks from the start, around specified government marks, as specified in **Attachment A**, and then to the finish.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 The PHRF classes will be scored using time on time, using TCF = 650 / (550+PHRF).
- 9.2 PHRF and Plus One Racing boats will use their PHRF Distance Rating.

10 RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 10.1 The Race Committee may provide general information to competitors on VHF Channel 71. Information so provided will not be subject to action under Rule 62.
- 10.2 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

11 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at the *Post Race "Chili" Party*, to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for each class.

12 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

13 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000.00 per incident or the equivalent.
