NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[DP]' in a rule in this Notice of Race (NoR) means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification. All times are US Eastern Time.

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 J/105 Class Rules are modified as follows:
- (a) Class Rule 3.10 is deleted.
- (b) The first sentence of Class Rule 3.4 is deleted.
- 1.3 J/105 Class Rules are modified by Article 9 of the local J/105 Fleet-3 Article/Rules. This event is designated Level 3A. (J/105 Fleet-3 Articles/Rules can be found at https://www.j105fleet3.org/rules).
- 1.4 RRS Rule 41 applies.

2 COMMUNICATIONS

- 2.1 The official notice board is electronic and is located here:

- 2.2 On the water, the race committee intends to make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the SIs.
- 2.3 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 9, 13, 16, 68, 69, 70, 71, and 72.
- 2.4 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 Boats in the J/105 class are invited to participate.
- 3.2 A boat shall have an all-female crew. If male owner representative is present, they may not provide any materially substantial support (e.g., actions to ensure safety of crew and vessel only)
- 3.3 Boats wishing to enter shall register online at: https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=15737
- 3.4 To be considered an entry in the regatta, a boat shall complete all registration, inspection steps and pay all fees.

4 FEES

4.1 Registration and entry fee of \$150 are due by 1700 on Friday, August 18th. Late entries will be accepted until 1700 on Wednesday, August 30th with a late fee of \$200. Entry fees are non-refundable.

5 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 The racing day will be Sunday, September 3rd.
- 5.2 The warning signal for the first race of the regatta is scheduled for Sunday, September 3rd at 1100.
- 5.3 Three (3) races are scheduled.
- 5.4 No warning signal will be made after 1600.

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The SIs will be available on the notice board approximately 10 days before the scheduled day of racing.

7 VENUE

- 7.1 The racing area will be the CBYRA Region 3 Racing Area off the mouth of the Severn River.
- 7.2 The location details for social events will be posted on the notice board.

8 THE COURSES

8.1 The courses to be sailed will be drop mark courses.

9 PENALTIES

9.1 US Sailing Prescription Appendix V1 - PENALTY AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT will apply.

10 SCORING

- 10.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 10.2 One completed race is required to constitute a regatta.
- 10.3 A boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. This modifies RRS Appendix A2.

11 [DP] SUPPORT BOATS

11.1 Support vessels shall comply with CR 7.10.

12 PRIZES

- 12.1 Prizes will be given for the top 5 boats.
- 12.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the organizing authority.

13 SKIPPER-CREW-BOAT MATCHING

- 13.1 Owners interested in lending their boats and sailors interested in skippering or crewing sign up on Crew/Boat/Charter Board on the website: https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=15737

14.1 Teams interested in practicing are encouraged to race in both the <u>One-Design Classic - Eastport Yacht Club (eastportyc.org)</u> to be held June 17th, and <u>Fawcett Friday Night Beer Can Series - Eastport Yacht Club (eastportyc.org)</u> beginning June 7th.

16.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum coverage of \$300,000 per incident or the equivalent.
