DISTANCE RACES - AMENDMENT #1

Organizing Authorities (OA's): Burnham Park Yacht Club (BPYC), Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club (CCYC), Chicago Yacht Club (CYC), Columbia Yacht Club (COLYC), Jackson Park Yacht Club (JPYC), Michigan City Yacht Club (MCYC), St. Joseph River Yacht Club (SJRYC), and Waukegan Yacht Club (WYC).

CASRA NOTICE OF RACES - DISTANCE RACES AMENDEMENT #1

The Notice of Race - Distance Races is amended as follows:

Replace section 1.4 with:

- 1.4 For single and double handed racer, mechanical (wind vane) or electrically operated auto-pilots may be used during racing. This changes RRS 52.
- 1.4.1 For single-handed racers, boats shall have a functional mechanical (wind vane) or electrically operated auto-pilot installed and ready for use while racing. Wheel and tiller locks do not meet this rule.
- 1.4.2 For double-handed racers, boats participating in the Chicago to Waukegan Race, Waukegan to Chicago Race, Chicago-Michigan City-Chicago Race, Third Coast Cup and the Bi-State and Tri-State Races, shall have a functional mechanical (wind vane) or electrically operated auto-pilot installed and ready for use while racing. For all other races listed it is strongly recommended that boats have a functional auto-pilot installed and ready for use. Wheel and tiller locks do not meet this rule.

DISTANCE RACES - AMENDMENT #1

Replace section 4.4 with:

- 4.4 For each Race, the OA(s) will provide separate classes for multihull and "jib and main" entrants if sufficient entrants exist.
- 4.4.1. Boats racing double-handed shall register online in the appropriate One-Design class or Handicap section for which their boat is eligible and also register online with the OA as a double-handed competitor.

Amend section 10 to add the following:

10.3 Boats racing double-handed will be scored in the One-Design class or Handicap section for which their boat qualifies and also in a double-handed class comprising all double-handed entries across all classes and sections.

Amend section 14 to add the following:

- 14.1 Boats racing double-handed will be eligible for any awards for the class or section for which they registered.
- 14.2 Prizes will also be awarded to the best double-handed boat across all sections regardless of their rank within a class. The prizes will be given as follows:

Number of double-handed boats	Prizes
1-4	1
5-6	2
7-14	3
15-19	4
20 or more	5
