FIRST AMENDMENT

TO THE

SAILING INSTRUCTIONS (SIs)

- 10 THE START is replaced with
- 10.1 Races will be started in accordance with RRS 26.
- The starting line and finish line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel and the course side of an orange MarkSetBot on the opposite end. This changes Race Signals.
- 10.4 If any part of a boat's hull is on the course side of the starting line at her starting signal and she is identified, the race committee will attempt to hail boats OCS over the regatta VHF channel. Either sail numbers or bow numbers will be used to identify boats OCS and the Race Committee will identify which numbers they are using for a given boat. Failure to hail her number, failure of her to hear such a hail, or the order in which boats are hailed will not be grounds for a redress for request. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- 10.5 A boat that does not start within five minutes after her starting signal will be scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS A5.1 and A5.2.
- 10.6 Signal flag K (yellow and blue), flown prior to or with the warning signal, means no spinnakers for this race.

18 CLEANING OF HULLS

Boats shall not be cleaned with sandpaper or any other abrasive cleanser.
