1. Rules

1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and as modified by the 2023 J35 One Design Class rules, and the Catalina 22 National Sailing Association rules, this notice of race, and the sailing instructions for this regatta.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This regatta is open to J/35 and Catalina 22 class boats equipped as specified in ORC Category 4 regulations including RRS prescriptions in accordance with the rules and descriptions described above and are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA, or US Sailing, and who have paid their race fees.
- 2.2 Registration shall be submitted according to registration instructions on YachtScoring.com, also a link is available on the NSSC website (NorthStarSail.org/Racing) that will direct you to YachtScoring.com.
- **2.3** Entry deadline is 48 hours prior to the regatta. Late entries will be accepted up to 2 hours before the race, and subject to a **\$25.00 late fee**.

3.1 The entry fee for this regatta is \$120.00

4. Schedule


- **4.1** Skippers' meeting, Saturday, August 26, 2023, 0830 hours, at North Star Sail Clubs riverfront.
- **4.2** The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 1030 hours each day.
- **4.3** The intention is to run as many races over the two days as possible.
- **4.4** No races will be started after 1500 hours on Saturday or after 1430 hours on Sunday.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1 Sailing instructions will be posted on YachtScoring.com no later than one week prior to the event.

6. Venue

- **6.1** The regatta harbor will be North Star Sail Club, 32041 S. River Rd, Harrison Township, MI 48045.
- **6.2** The racing area will be Anchor Bay, Lake St. Clair. The chart shows the approximate location of the racing area.



7. Courses

7.1 The regatta will use windward/leeward courses.

7.2 Course selection will be visually communicated to competitors prior to each warning signal.

8. Scoring

8.1 RRS A2 is unchanged. One race completed constitutes a series.
