

NOTICE OF RACE HAMPTON ONE-DESIGN NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP

with NOR Amendment #1 incorporated

**Hampton One Design Class Racing Association
Hampton, Virginia - August 11, 12 & 13, 2023**

WHERE: Registration and launch facilities at the Hampton Yacht Club, Hampton, Virginia. Races will be sailed on the Hampton Flats.

WHEN: Registration and check-in for this regatta will be from 1000-1150 on Friday, August 11. A competitors meeting will be held at noon on that day. Six races are scheduled as follows:

No races will be started after 1500, Sunday, August 13. Four races must be completed to constitute a series. There will be a throw-out if all six races are completed.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), together with the prescriptions of US Sailing, the Hampton One Design class rules and the Sailing Instructions.

CLASSES: All Hampton One Design owners that are current members of the HOD Class are eligible to enter. The Hampton One Design National Executive Committee will make final decisions on eligibility, including waiver of eligibility requirements.

EQUIPMENT: Competitors are reminded that the class rules require each boat to carry a paddle, an anchor, 50 feet of anchor line, and life jackets for the skipper and crew. This equipment must be available for verification by class measurers between 1000 and 1150 Friday morning. The Sailing Instructions will also specify the use of **VHF radios** for all competitors, and the Race Committee may use VHF radios to communicate important information to competitors.

ENTRY FEE: Competitors must pre-register; registration materials and instructions available at Yacht Scoring at <https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=15888> The **early** registration fee is ~~\$350~~ **\$270**, which includes 3 days of racing, **and** dinner ~~and parties~~ on ~~Friday and~~ Saturday nights for skipper and crew. ~~along with lunch every day.~~ Breakfast will be available in the clubhouse for purchase on Saturday and Sunday mornings beginning at 8am. ~~An additional \$50 will be charged if registration is not paid by July 28th.~~ Pre-registered competitors must check in at the registration table on Friday morning between 1000 and 1150 for Sailing Instructions, equipment forms, and meal tickets. Additional guest tickets for the ~~Friday and~~ Saturday dinners may be purchased via the registration form (preferable), or at check-in on Friday. Any competitors who registered prior to the reduced entry fee posted 8/4/23 will be refunded the difference.
