## **RULES**

## **ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

Eligibility is limited to Atlantic owners and charter skippers who are members of the Atlantic Class Association with their dues paid.

## **DOCUMENTS & FORMS**

Please be aware that the "Documents & Forms" in Yacht Scoring will be used for various documents and information you will need for the regatta.

## The General Entry Fee is \$1000 per boat, which includes:

- Six championship races (if time and weather permit)
- > Starling Burgess Cup Around Long Island Race (if time and weather permit)
- Dinners for four on Monday (opening dinner), Wednesday, Thursday (Nationals Series closing dinner).
- Lunch is NOT provided- please see the info sheet on the Yacht Scoring Website "Documents & Forms" for ideas about various lunch options etc.
- Friday prizes, cash bar, beer & hors d'oeuvres following the Starling Burgess cup.
- 4 Atlantic Nationals Logo Baseball Caps
- Post-race Tea on Tuesday, & Wednesday.
- Atlantic Nationals 2023 keeper trophies for skipper and three crew for top five finishers
- Starling Burgess Cup keeper trophy for top three finishers
- Moorings for Atlantics and support craft

Entry application requires the entry form, entry fee, proof of insurance, as well as the KYC Understanding & Responsibility form- signed by each skipper, and the certification form signed by a Rules Committee member. This last document will be located on Yacht Scoring's "Documents & Forms" and may be a paper document to be handed in when you check in at KYC, or submitted anytime to Sean Guinness via e-mail: chris@happynomad.com

## **CERTIFICATION**

Section 17 (Championship Series) of the Atlantic Class Association Rules shall apply. Entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by a completed Certification Form which has been signed by a Rules Committee Member.

The instructions will be posted on the official notice board located inside the KYC clubhouse adjacent to the club entrance and will be reviewed at the Skippers' Meeting at 11 AM on Tuesday, August 15th.

## **CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Changes to sailing instructions will be posted on the official notice board at KYC before 8:00 AM on the day they will take effect, except that any change in the schedule of races will be posted by 7:00 PM on the day before it will take effect. Skippers will be notified by text and/or email via Yacht Scoring, as well as information being posted at KYC.

#### COURSES

Courses will be windward - leeward. Further details will be shown in the Sailing Instructions.

#### SCORING

Six races are scheduled. Three completed races constitute a series. A boat's worst score shall be excluded if 5 or more races are sailed.
