

NOTICE OF RACE CYCCM Dead Crab Regatta

June 18-19, 2016
Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May NJ
PHRF and J-70 class boats

- 1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY- The Corinthian Yacht Club of Cape May (CYCCM) and the J-70 Fleet 24 are pleased to invite sailors of offshore sail boats to participate in the Dead Crab Regatta. This regatta is open to members and guests.
- 2. Rules-
- **2.1** The Dead Crab Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Regatta Sailing Instructions (SI).
- **2.2**.Open to mono hull PHRF and, J70 Class boats. Individual fleet starts will be provided for PHRF fleet and the J-70 fleet.
- **2.3** Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY-

- 3.1 J-70 CLASS Boats must meet Class Rules
- **3.2** PHRF Fleet participants must have a valid PHRF Certificate.
- 3.3 All boats must be equipped with a working VHF radio.
- 3.4 All boats must have sail numbers
 - **4. FEES** -The Regatta entry fee for boats registered for 2016 CYCCM Offshore series shall be \$40 per boat.
- 4.1.1 The Regatta entry fee for all other boats (not registered for CYCCM Offshore series) (CYCCM members or, guests) shall be **\$55.00 per boat**.
- 4.1.2 Entry fee covers awards, breakfast and after race refreshments, and regatta supplies and expenses.
- **4.2** For boats participating in the 2016 CYCCM Offshore Series, the results from Dead Crab Regatta races shall be included in the LOR series scoring.
 - 5. REGISTRATION Competitors shall register and pay in advance no later than Thursday June 17, 2016, online at: www.yachtscoring.com and, complete the Event Registration Form and a signed Waiver, submitting both at Final

registration **Saturday June 18, 2016.** Event Entry and Waiver forms will be posted at www.yachtscoring.com

- 6. ACCOMODATIONS Visitors who would like to deliver their boat before the regatta may keep their boat on club property for up to one week, before or after the regatta. Please notify the Fleet Captain Bob Herzog in advance. Boat owner assumes all risks for boats while on club property. We can also help with local accommodations or hotel recommendations. Participants must not park vehicles in the boat storage yard!
- 7. MOORING and LAUNCHING CYCCM has recently completed dredging of the boat basin. A 2 ton, maximum capacity, club hoist is available for launching and retrieving trailer-able boats. Draft of 4 feet at mean low tide is available at the hoist and 5 feet at club docks. Boats using club facilities must be willing to allow other boats to raft up. Participants must bring suitable lines and fenders for mooring.

1100 SUN, June 19	First of up to 2 races scheduled, Awards presentation

No races shall be started after 16:30 on SAT Jun 18. No race shall be started after 14:45 on SUN Jun19

The Club house dining room and bar will be open Friday evening June 18. Guests must sign the club guest register.

- **9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS -** The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be available at Final Registration and on the web at: www.yachtscoring.com. If any class rules or NOR rules are in conflict with the SI, the SI rules shall supersede.
- 10. COURSES Shall be windward- leeward or, Olympic. Race area shall be located off Cape May (West of 2CM) or off Wildwood Crest (East of 2CM) depending on conditions.
- **11. Protests -** Shall be heard in the order received and must be submitted pursuant to the Sailing Instructions. Boats should have on board: a Red protest flag and, Yellow protest acknowledgement flag, able to be flown conspicuously from the backstay.

- **12. SCORING -** A maximum of **5** races are scheduled, of which **1** shall be completed to constitute a regatta. There will be no throw outs. The Low Point Scoring System under RRS Appendix A shall be used.
- **13.SAFETY -** The skipper and crews are responsible for the safety and fitness of the boats and participants to compete. Each boat participating must turn in a signed waiver at final registration.
- 14. MEDIA RIGHTS By participating in this regatta, a competitor (or parent/guardian if under age 18) grants to the OA and its sponsors the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any photographs, motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of him or her during the period of the competition without compensation.
- **15. PRIZES- Awards** shall be made for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place finishes in each class.
