## NOTICE OF RACE

### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 J/105 Class Rules are modified by Article IX of the local J-105 Fleet 3 Article/Rules. This event is designated a Level 1A event. J/105 Fleet 3 Articles/Rules can be found at https://www.j105fleet3.org/rules.
- 1.3 ORC class rules are as modified by ORC of the Chesapeake, which can be found at https://www.orcches.org.

### 2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions (SIs) will be posted on the Official Notice Board approximately ten (10) days before the first scheduled day of racing.

#### 3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at eastportyc.org/aldr.
- 3.2 [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 9, 13, 16, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72 and 73.
- 3.3 On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio. The specific channel will be stated in the SIs.

# 4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 The event is open to all boats of the ORC Open, ORC Racer/Cruiser, ORC Cruiser, PHRF (A0/A1, A2, B, C, N, Cruiser), Cal 25, J/30, J/35, J/70, J/80, J/105, and Viper 640 classes.
- For a class to have a start, it must have a minimum of five (5) valid entries by 1200 on Friday, September 1, 2023. Entry fees for boats in classes that fail to meet the minimum will be returned.
- 4.4 Competitors in handicap classes shall have the appropriate valid 2023 ORC rating certificate.
- 4.5 Boats wishing to enter shall register online at eastportyc.org/aldr
- 4.6 To be considered a valid entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements including the waiver and pay all fees.

### 5 FEES

- 5.1 Early registration and entry fee of \$80 is due by 1700 on Monday, August 14, 2023. After that registration and entry fee of \$105 will be accepted until 1200 on Friday, September 1, 2023. Entry fees are payable in full upon registering and are non-refundable.
- 5.2 The entry fee includes, at a minimum, racing and awards.

## 6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the regatta is 1100.
- 6.2 Three (3) windward-leeward drop-mark races are scheduled for PHRF B, PHRF C, Cal 25, J/30, J/70, J/80, and Viper 640 classes.
- 6.3 ORC Open, PHRF A0/A1, PHRF A2, J/35, and J/105 classes will sail two (2) windward-leeward drop-mark races.
- 6.4 ORC Racer/Cruiser, ORC Cruiser, PHRF N, and PHRF Cruiser classes will sail one (1) government marks race.
- 6.5 No warning signal will be made after 1530.
- 6.6 An Awards Party will be held at the Eastport Yacht Club on Saturday, following racing. Additional information will be available in the Notice to Competitors.

## 7 VENUE

- 7.1 The event venue will be the Eastport Yacht Club, 317 First Avenue, Annapolis, MD, 21403.
- 7.2 The racing area will be on Chesapeake Bay, off the mouth of the Severn River.

### 8 COURSES

- 8.1 The ORC Open, PHRF A0/A1, PHRF A2, PHRF B, PHRF C, Cal 25, J/30, J/35, J/70, J/80, J/105, and Viper 640 classes shall sail drop marks courses.
- 8.2 The ORC Racer/Cruiser, ORC Cruiser, PHRF N, and PHRF Cruiser classes shall sail a Government mark course.

#### 9 SCORING

- 9.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply as changed by the SIs.
- 9.2 Corrected times for ORC classes will be calculated using ORC Time-on-Time ratings. The race committee will assign the appropriate course type and wind strength prior to scoring, as detailed in the SIs.

### 10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

RRS 3 states "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue *racing* is hers alone."

#### 11 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per incident.

### 12 PRIZES

- 12.1 Prizes will be given in each class for 1<sup>st</sup> place with three (3) or more starters (boats starting in at least one (1) race), 2<sup>nd</sup> place with six (6) or more starters, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place with nine (9) or more starters.
- 12.2 The Organizing Authority (OA) anticipates that the following perpetual trophies will be awarded (as further described in the SIs):
  - a) City of Annapolis Trophy: overall performance.
  - b) SpinSheet Junior Varsity and Varsity Trophies: best performance by boats with junior sailors aboard.
  - c) Eleanor Ruth Wilcox Trophy: best performance by a boat with a female skipper.
- 12.2 Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the OA.
