# 2024 Race Week Anacortes SI Amendment 1

**Change SI 2.1.** Any changes to the Sailing Instructions, except an oral change made under SI 2.2, will be posted on the official notice board by 0900 on the day it takes effect, except any change in the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 on the day before it will take affect

Add SI 2.2. – SAILING INSTRUCTIONS CHANGES MADE ON THE WATER In accordance with RRS 90.2 (c), oral changes to the Sailing Instructions may be made on the water. A change is in effect when the RC signal boat displays code flag *L* over *C* with one sound signal. This means come within hail of the Race Committee boat to receive the oral changes to the Sailing Instructions.

#### Add SI 7.2 - CLASS FLAGS Racecourse Bravo.

The J/70 flag will be the **J-pod** flag as shown here:



# **Change SI 12.2 – Racecourse Bravo change marks**

To change the next leg of the course to the weather mark for the 6 meters the RC will move the original mark to a new position. If the weather mark is changed, the offset mark may be removed. To change the next leg of the course to all other marks, the RC will lay a new mark. If the leeward gate is moved, it will be replaced with a single mark.

### Addendum B: Recourse Bravo Courses and Marks:

In the mark description table

'| Finish | All | Blue/White Checkered Inflatable |' is changed.

'| New Mark | J70 | TBD | 'is removed.

## Add SI 16.4 - SCORING - ORC

ORC Fleets will be scored using Triple Number Windward/Leeward rating. The median wind speed in the time around a fleet's start will be used. If the wind changes significantly for more than half the race, the new wind speed will be used and decided on prior to the first boat finishing. Low wind may be less than 9 knots, Medium wind may be between 8-15 knots, and High wind may be greater than 14 knots. The RC will announce the starting wind range before the start on VHF and the WhatsApp Announcements group, and will announce if an adjustment is made during the race prior to the first boat finishes. Decisions of which rating to use is the decision of the RC and not subject to redress.

## Add to Addendum A - Mark Descriptions

Mark Q – Red Inflatable mark to weather  $\frac{1}{2}$  nm or more of the yellow weather A mark. This is intended to be used only for the fastest fleets. L flag will be flown and its location will be announced over VHF and the WhatsApp Announcements group prior to the Preparatory signal for any races that will use it.

#### Add SI AC2.1 to Addendum C - PURSUIT - ORC

ORC Boats' start time for the pursuit will be calculated based on the course distance and their Single Number either All Purpose or Windward Leeward rating, picked by the RC the night before the race and announced with the Pursuit announcement. Although boats will be scored in the pursuit by fleet, The ORC start times will be related to the PHRF start times by using the Median ORC boat's APH and PHRF ToD handicaps.
