## SUMMARY DOCUMENT FOR TROPHIES AND AWARDS IN TROPHY DATABASE

Name in Database: AYC J/105 Regatta Series

Description: Wooden plaque with engraved brass annual recipient plates.

**Current Purpose:** Awarded to the best overall performance in the J/105 class in a series of AYC races and regattas (excluding Chesapeake Bay Championships, Wednesday Night Races and Frosbites).

**History:** To be awarded beginning in 2024. Presented annually thereafter by Annapolis Yacht Club exclusively for the J/105 class.

Ownership and Custody: The trophy is currently owned by AYC. This Trophy is in the custody of the Fleet Captain and will be displayed in the Sailing Center or Clubhouse.

Selection Process: The AYC J/105 Regatta Series Trophy is awarded to the top low point scoring boat in the J/105 class in a series of five AYC events consisting of Spring OD Regatta, Spring Race to Oxford, Annual Regatta, Fall Race to Solomons and Fall Series. A boat qualifies by competing in at least one event of the series. Each boat's series score shall be the total of her final event scores excluding her worst score. The boat with the lowest series score wins and others shall be ranked accordingly.

A boat that did not start, did not finish, retired after finishing or was disqualified will be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of qualifiers in this series.

If there is a series score tie between two or more boats, each boat's final event scores shall be listed in order of best to worst and at the first point where there is a difference the tie shall be broken in favor of the boat(s) with the best scores. No excluded score shall be used.

If a tie remains between two or more boats, they shall be ranked in order of their score in the last event of the series. Any remaining ties shall be broken by using the tied boats' scores in the next to last event and so on until all ties are broken. These scores shall be used even if some of them include an excluded score.

**Keeper Trophy and Budget:** The winner of this Trophy will receive an appropriate keeper trophy to be determined by the Race Committee. Budget authority is the Race Committee.

Presentation: As determined by AYC.

Modification of this Document: The Race Committee will receive a copy of this document. They are requested to inform the Sailing Committee of any conditions of the proposed Notice of Race for any year which may conflict with this document.

**Disposition and Rededication:** Since there is no Deed of Gift, if the current purpose cannot be met, the Race Committee is requested to advise the Sailing Committee who will determine if this trophy shall be retired or rededicated to another appropriate race.
