
Lodging

Tip: The Democratic National Convention is in Chicago from Aug 19-22 2024. Traveling boats are encouraged to book your lodging for the T10 NAC ASAP.

The following hotels are recommended for traveling boats; Each is within approx. 1 mi radius of the Chicago Yacht Club Belmont Station.

The Lakeview / Lincoln Park neighborhoods are walkable and have numerous shops, restaurants and services available. AirBNB and VRBO properties are also widely available.

Non-Vehicle Transportation

Chicago has extensive Blue "Divvy" bikes as well as electric scooters from a variety of providers (e.g. Uber, Lime) that can be utilized for transportation within the neighborhood as well as to and from the Chicago Yacht Club. Download the Divvy app on your mobile device's app store. Please note that electric scooters are not allowed on the lakeshore paths and geo-fencing is utilized to shut them down within approx. 1 block of the lake. E-bikes and manual pedaling bikes are permitted in all locations.







Daily Parking

Daily Paid Parking is available at the south-end of Belmont harbor (orange-green highlight below). Payment is made using a mobile app, instructions are posted in the lot. **No free daily parking is available at the Chicago Yacht Club during the event.**




T10 Towing Routes

The following information is provided for boats that are traveling and towing a T10 to CYC Belmont Station. You are ultimately responsible for the safe towing of your vessel the following guidance is provided to you for information only.

T10 Towing Information:

- 1. Exit the I-90/94 expressway onto eastbound Armitage Avenue.
- 2. From eastbound Armitage Avenue turn left onto northbound Ashland Avenue.
- 3. Continue on northbound Armitage to Belmont Avenue, turn right onto eastbound Belmont Avenue.
- 4. When approaching DuSable Lakeshore Drive on eastbound Belmont Avenue take up both lanes of traffic and proceed directly under the center part of the Belmont-LSD overpass. Ensure that you are directly under the highest crown of the Belmont-LSD overpass.
- 5. Turn right after the overpass onto Belmont Harbor Access Road.
