SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - Buoy Event Amendment 2, Posted 27-JUL-2024

SI 3.2 is replaced with the following, removing reference to Circle 2:

On the water, the RC will monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 71. For the buoy event the event flag is T.

SI 6.3 is amended with the following:

6.3 Competitors are advised that classes may be combined in the starting order but will still be scored separately. The RC will signal combined starts by flying multiple class flags at the warning signal.

SI 7.1 is replaced by the following, removing reference to Circle 2:

	Circle 1
Approx. Heading	3.7 NM at 67° from Monroe Harbor entrance
Approx. Location	041° 54.0′ N, 087° 32.0′W

SI 9.1 is replaced with the following, removing reference to Circle 2:

9.1 The marks for each circle are shown below:

Mark	Mark designation for Circle 1
Start	Yellow
Finish	White
Windward	Orange
Offset	Orange
Gate	Orange
Change	Yellow

SI 11.1.1 is amended as follows:

11.1.1 The RC may modify the starting sequence after the first race in the regatta each day for any subsequent races. As per SI 6.3, the RC may combine classes in the starting order and change such combination after the first race of in the regatta.

SI 11.4, 11.4.1, 11.4.2, 11.4.3. and 11.4.4 are deleted and replaced with the following SI 11.4:

- 11.4 If there is a significant wind shift during a starting sequence, the Race Committee may signal a change of course for a class as follows:
 - (a) At the preparatory signal, flag C will be displayed with repetitive sounds and will remain up until the starting signal.
 - (b) The signaled fleet will sail to the change mark.
 - (c) If there is a subsequent change and the new mark is replaced, it will be replaced by an original mark. This changes RRS 27 and 33.
