

3 Crib Fiasco

NOTICE OF RACE



Saturday, September 21, 2024 Organizing Authority (OA) – Columbia Yacht Club (COLYC) Chicago, IL USA

This Notice of Race provides basic information about the **Columbia Yacht Club - 3 Crib Fiasco**, a fun pursuit race, whose course takes you around a number of the Chicago Water Cribs, **in whichever direction the skipper chooses**. The notation '[NP]' in a rule in the notice of race (NoR) means that the rule shall not be grounds for protest or request for redress by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a). The Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions are available on <u>https://yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eid=16413</u> and will not be available as paper copies at the event.

1. RULES

- a) These Races will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- **b)** Boats shall comply with US Coast Guard safety requirements.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- a) The sailing instructions including courses will be available on or before September 14, 2024, at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>.
- **b)** This will be a Pursuit Race for which competitor starting times will be provided on <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u> no later than Friday, September 20, 2024.
- c) The Race Committee (RC) will use VFH channel 71.
- **d)** To facilitate sharing of information and learning, boats are permitted to make voice or data transmissions via VHF radio and may provide advice and coaching to each other. This changes RRS 41.

3. COMMUNICATION

- a) Official notice board at the relevant Yachtscoring.com event page.
- **b)** [DP] All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 71 and 16.
- c) On the water, the RC will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on channel 71.
- **d)** Please use VHF channel 71 to notify the RC of a decision to retire from the race.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a) The Race is open to all boats of at least 24 feet length overall.
- b) All boats shall register by Wednesday, September 18, 2024 at 2359, online at <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>. Boats entered at Yacht Scoring but not paying the fee are not registered for the race and not entitled to sail in the race or win prizes. Unpaid registrations will be removed prior to the race.
- c) Boats will be divided into classes. Entrants will be asked to self-identify as one of the following four classes with minimum of 2 vessels per class:

<u>Class</u>	Description	
Racing Spin	Competitive racing boats - Spinnaker	
Racing JAM	Competitive racing boats - Jib and Main	
Green Fleet Spin	Cruisers and occasional racers - Spinnaker	
Green Fleet JAM	Cruisers and occasional racers - Jib and Main	
Short Handed	1 and 2 Crew	

- d) There will be no class or division changes allowed after Wednesday, September 18, 2024 at 2359.
- e) Because boats are of different sizes and speeds, it is necessary to use a handicapping system to properly determine the starting times for this pursuit race. Midwest Performance Fleet (MWPHRF) general and non-Spinnaker handicaps will be used if they exist.
- f) Boats that do not have a valid MWPHRF certificate or will be racing in a configuration different from that declared for the MWPHRF certificate shall apply for a temporary handicap by submitting a rating request to the event contact, no later than Monday, September 16, 2024, by 1700. The assignment of 3 Crib Fiasco temporary handicaps are offered as an accommodation and such handicaps are not subject to competitor review or protest.
- g) Shorthanded (sailing vessels with 1 and 2 crew), with a minimum of 2 entries.
 - i. Power-driven winches, mechanical and electro-mechanical steering devices permitted. This changes RRS 52.
 - ii. If there are a minimum of 2 single handed entrants and 2 double handed entrants, then a separate section will be created for each.
 - iii. While racing each crew member in a shorthanded section must have a PFD, properly fitted and worn when not below decks or while briefly changing gear/clothing.

5. FEES

a) Entry fee for this race is \$55?

6. ADVERTISING

Boats are urged to refrain from displaying advertisements for businesses or products competing with those of the primary and support sponsors of the event.

8. VENUE AND COURSES

- a) The long course will be sailing around the three Chicago Cribs (Wilson Ave, William E. Dever and Four Mile) in either direction with the approximate starting line North of Navy Pier and west of Harrison-Dever Crib.
- **b)** An alternative course will be offered to accommodate any need for a shorter race.

9. PENALTY SYSTEM

- a) RRS Appendix T is in effect (Arbitration)
- **b)** RRS Appendix V2 is in effect (Post race penalty prior to start of a protest hearing)
- c) RRS Appendix V1 is in effect (Penalty at the time of an incident)
- a) RRS 44.3 is not in effect (scoring penalty at the time of the incident).

10. SCORING

- a) Boats will start in the reverse order of their PHRF ToD handicap.
- **b)** Boats will be scored in order of finishing place, as the starting times account for handicaps.

11. BERTHING

There will be a limited amount of complimentary dockage available Saturday, September 21, 2024, for attending activities at COLYC. Please contact dock@colyc.org for details.

12. PRIZES

a) Prizes will be given for first, second, and third places for the classes below. If only 2 entries, a prize will be given for only first place:

- i. Racing Fleet Jib and Main
- ii. Green Fleet Jib and Main
- iii. Racing Fleet Spinnaker
- iv. Green Fleet Spinnaker
- v. Short Handed

13. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with minimum coverage of \$500,000 per incident or the equivalent.

- b) Competitors waive any rights of privacy or publicity in connection with the use of their name, Recordings or Statements waive the right to credit or acknowledgement in conjunction with their identity, Recordings or Statements and acknowledge that they shall have no right to inspect or approve any use of their identity, Recordings or Statements.

16. RISK, DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY, PERSONAL CONDUCT

- a) Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race. Competitors acknowledge that sailing involves potential risks. As a condition of their participation in this regatta, competitors release all claims they may have against Columbia Yacht Club and its officers, directors, members, committees, volunteers, and employees for damage to property, personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
- b) The Skipper/Owner of each boat participating in the regatta shall be responsible for the behavior of each member of the crew of his/her boat both on the water and while ashore. The destruction of property, the breach of reasonable standards of good sportsmanship by any crew member, or any other person associated with the boat, or the failure of any of those persons to comply with any reasonable request of any Race Officer, Regatta Committee member, or their representatives, may result in the disqualification of the boat.
