NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

PARKING AT EYC

Parking in the EYC lot is restricted to EYC members who display a valid parking sticker; violators will be towed at the owner's expense. Guest parking is available across the street in the Yacht Haven lot after 1700 on Friday, on a first-come basis. Additional parking is available on the surrounding streets.

DOCKAGE AT EASTPORT YACHT CLUB

Out-of-town boats that wish to launch and/or haul and/or berth at EYC on Friday, 23 August 2024 are encouraged to contact the EYC Waterfront Director as early as possible to make the necessary arrangements (<u>waterfront@eastportyc.org</u>; (410) 990-0765). Available space will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. Competitors should not assume space will be available at EYC if they do not first coordinate with the Waterfront Director.

EYC extends the courtesy of its galley and bar to competitors.

DOCKAGE AT CAMBRIDGE YACHT CLUB

For vessels who prefer to have a slip for the night, please reserve your CYC slip via DOCKWA. Alternatively, in the event there are no vacancies at CYC, contact the City Municipal Marina (dockmaster@choosecambridge.com; (410) 228-4031).




Figure 1. Cambridge Yacht Club Docking Arrangements

Racers are invited to dock at CYC **FREE OF CHARGE** on any of the T-heads (I, J, K, L, and M), and along the floating breakwater north of the club (purple dots); refer to Figure 1. These are first come, first serve basis. Rafting is permitted on the T-heads and the breakwater but only two-wide. There is no water or electric on the breakwater.

 \Rightarrow CYC volunteers will monitor VHF channel 71 and be ready to assist skippers upon arrival in the CYC marina.

 \Rightarrow It is strongly advised to not utilize the breakwater during any type of moderate ENE wind, and/or dock at the seam of the concrete floats as there are mooring chains that extend from both sides.

Vessels that draw 6' or less will be fine along the floating pier. Cleats are along the inside only. The approach and fairway of the yacht basin generally carry 8' of water. For vessels that draw more than 7.5', we recommend you contact the City Municipal Yacht Basin for arrangements along the shipping wharf, or plan to anchor off the club grounds.

Free ice will be available to ALL competitiors.

DOCKAGE OFF OR NEAR CAMBRIDGE YACHT CLUB

There is good holding ground directly NW of the marina. The City Municipal Marina is a nearby alternative if there is no vacancy at CYC
