NOTICE OF RACE

Welcome to the 68th Miami Key Largo Regatta! We hope you and your friends will join us for a weekend of fantastic long-distance racing on the bay, with the proceeds from the event benefiting the Miami Yacht Club Youth Sailing Foundation.

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The organizing authority is the MYC Youth Sailing Foundation.

2. RULES

- 2.1 These Races will be governed by the 2021 2024 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) as adopted by the US Sailing Association except where changes by the sailing instructions.
- 2.2 The Class rules will be used except that RRS are changed to prohibit a boat from protesting another boat for an alleged breach of a class rule requiring class membership.
- 2.3 The requirements of RRS, Appendix G, ISAF markings on sails shall not apply
- 2.4 There are no PHRF crew restrictions on number or weight of crew.
- 2.5 All boats must have a towline available of at least 20 feet.
- 2.6 All competitors sailing on beach cats and open/non-cruising sailing boats, skiffs and dinghies must wear an US Coast Guard approved PFD while racing.

3. ENTRY

The Miami to Key Largo Regatta (MKL) is open to all boats 14ft & over that submit a completed entry form. Entries should be submitted on www.yachtscoring.com. For any regatta participants under the age of 18, an additional waiver is required. Chase boats for youth racers are also required and will not be provided by the MYC.

4. CLASSES

- 4.1 The following classes are expected to participate; ORC, PHRF, ARC, Hobie 16, F18, F16, Hobie 20, A-cat, SCHRS, MASF, J-24, J-70 and Flying Scots. Other classes may be added by sufficient participation of at least four boats.
- 4.2 ORC a valid 2023 ORC rating certificate must be submitted with the online application at the time of registry. For more information visit www.orc.org. Any vessel that carries multiple handicap rating certificates must indicate which handicap class rule she will be sailing under at the time of registry.
- 4.3 PHRF- a valid Southeast Florida 2023 PHRF rating certificate must be submitted with the online application. For more information visit www.phrfsef.com. Race Committee reserves the right to adjust rating for certificates outside the Southeast Florida Region. Any vessel that carries multiple handicap rating certificates must indicate which handicap class rule she will be

sailing under at the time of registry.

- 4.4 ARC (Assigned Rating Class) Entries without valid 2023 rating certificates will be assigned a rating and scored in the ARC fleet. Sufficient information about the vessel must be given to develop a rating. Ratings from previous races will be taken into consideration. If insufficient information is available to develop a rating, the boat will be scored in the "open" class with no handicap system in use. It is the skipper's responsibility to provide sufficient information for rating (see entry form).
- 4.5 Multi-hulls not racing in MASF or One Design classes will be scored on the SCHRS handicap system.
- 4.7 Trapeze rigs are not allowed unless provided for in the class rules for the boat using trapeze.
- 4.8 Final scratch sheets will be available at the skippers' meeting.
- 4.9 The fleets will be divided into Classes according to rating handicaps and other factors at the discretion of the Race Committee.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Draft Sailing Instructions for both races will be made available on www.yachtscoring.com. Final versions will be available at Skippers' meeting.

6. PARKING

- 6.1 Miami Yacht Club will be providing LIMITED onsite parking for autos and trailers on a first come first serve basis at \$20 per day for the weekend.
- Once management has made the determination that there is no longer room available on property, we will encourage participants to park on the grass outside property grounds for free. We've been advised that there will be security from Jungle Island watching the trailers. Your cars will also be permitted to park in the Jungle Island parking garage. 7. BOAT STORAGE

- 7.1 Beach Catamarans and dinghies are allowed to stage and enter the water from the MYC. Miami Yacht Club will also be offering limited dockage at \$1 per foot for the night before the race and dry storage available on a first come first serve basis.
- 7.2 We will have access to docking space for monohulls and multihulls at the Anchorage Resort & Yacht Club. The Anchorage has offered dock space at \$4.00 per foot with 28ft min. Management at The Anchorage has advised that they want no more than 6 persons per vessel overnight (on the boat). Reserve dock space early!
- 7.3 Please reserve your own individual dock space at Gilbert's Resort ahead of time.
- 7.4 Beach Cats will be able to pull out at the boat ramp and parking lot behind the Anchorage at a rate of \$32.50 ea. ROWELL'S WATERFRONT PARK WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE FOR BEACH CATAMARANS

8. ACCOMODATIONS

- 8.1 The Anchorage Resort will have hotel rooms available by special permission with a maximum of four guests per room. It is highly recommended that you book your rooms early.
- 8.2 Please book your own hotel room at Gilbert's Resort ahead of time.

9. ADVERTISING

As defined under RRS, Appendix 1 for Category A, unless modified by class rules to Category C. 9.0

10. HOSPITALITY

10.1 Reservations and information concerning hotels, trailer storage facilities, marinas and local restaurants are the responsibility of the entrants and crews.

11. FEES

- 11.1 Miami Key Largo and the Key Largo Miami: \$170 Early; \$200 Late
- 11.2 Miami Key Largo Race: \$120 Early; \$150 Late
- 11.3 Key Largo Miami Race: \$80 Early, \$100 Late
- 11.4 Late fees will be assessed from April 6, 2024, thenceforth

12. PRIZES

- 12.1 Trophies for both races will be given out at the Awards ceremony. The Perpetual Trophies remain on display at the Miami Yacht Club.
