Rules The race will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 –2016*, the prescriptions of the

United States Sailing Association and the Sailing Instructions.

The Essex Yacht Club strongly recommends entrants comply with the *US Safety Equipment Requirements for Coastal Races* available from USSA or the event website at yachtscoring.com.

Eligibility The regatta is open to yachts with a valid 2016 ECSA PHRF Certificate. Yachts must be

completely decked with a watertight cockpit, fitted with permanent berths capable of sleeping

at least half her racing crew, and with an adequate galley.

Entries Entries must be made and entry fees paid on the event website at <u>yachtscoring.com</u>. Entries

must be received by 1200 hours on Thursday August 11, 2016. The Race Committee may accept or reject entries made after this deadline at its sole discretion. The entry fee is \$40 per yacht (\$35 for members of USSA). Entries must have a valid 2016 ECSA PHRF rating certificate

on the ECSA website (ecsa.net).

Classes There will be spinnaker and non-spinnaker classes. Classes will be determined at the discretion

of the Race Committee and may be combined.

Sailing Instructions Sailing Instructions will be available at the Skippers Meeting at Essex Yacht Club at 1800 hours

on Thursday August 12, 2016 and on the event website at yachtscoring.com.

Schedule The First Warning will be at 1900 hours.

Start & Finish The Start and the Finish will be located approximately ¼ mile west of the Old Saybrook Outer

Light.

Courses The course selected will be signaled prior to the Start. Primary Course A: From the Start

around Block Island leaving Block Island and Bell "1BI" to port and thence to the Finish. Alternate Course B: From the Start around government mark GR "BIS" (approx. 7 miles NE of Montauk Light) to port and thence to the Finish. Yachts shall not pass Bell R "8" off the

Connecticut River to the north on any leg of the course.

Time Limit There is no time limit for finishing.

ScoringBoats will be scored using PHRF Time on Time handicaps. This race is an ECSA Offshore Circuit

Bonus Points race.
