Notice of Race

1 RULES: The Regatta will be governed by:

- 1.1 The racing rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 When rule 20 applies, a boat may indicate her need for room to take or her response both verbally and by VHF radio channel 72.

2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

- 2.1 Sailing Instruction will be available online at www.Yachtscoring.com and at the registration table.

3 COMMUNICATION

- 3.1 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions will be announced at registration.
- 3.2 All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on channels 16 and 72.

4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 4.1 All sailing vessels wishing to visit the three Virgins as part of a fun regatta.

4.2 The race committee may at its discretion create classes to make the regatta funner.
4.3 Early registration is required. Register online at www.Yachtscoring.com or in person at the December 5th Opening Reception.

5 FEES:

5.1 The entry fee for new participants in the regatta is \$200.
5.2 The entry fee for regatta alumni who have participated in one or more of the previous Three Sheets Regattas is \$150.

9. RISK STATEMENT AND DISCLAIMER OF RESPONSIBILITIES

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia, or other causes.
