1. RULES

1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1. Sailing Instructions shall be available online at www.mudhead.org/RACING after April 15, 2024.

3. COMMUNICATION

- 3.1. The Official Notice Board is online on YachtScoring.
- 3.2. Contact the Race Committee via email mudheadRC@gmail.com
- 3.3. The Race Committee will not monitor VHF radio during any MBR attempt.

4. ENTRY PROCEDURES & FEES

- 4.1. The event is open to all monohull and multihull sail powered boats who are members of MRMSA.
- 4.2. Eligible boats may register online at www.mudhead.org/RACING
- 4.3. Registration begins April 15 and ends October 31, 2024. Please register before each attempt.
- 4.4. Entry fee is \$10.00 per boat per attempt. Numerous attempts are encouraged.
- 4.5. Yachts select one of the following classes for each attempt:
 - 4.5.1. Asymmetrical Spinnaker
 - 4.5.2. Symmetrical Spinnaker
 - 4.5.3. Non-spinnaker
 - 4.5.4. Multihull
 - 4.5.5. Open

5. SCHEDULE

5.1. The racing window opens 0001 on May 1 and closes 2400 on Halloween, October 31, 2024.

6. THE COURSE

- 6.1. The racecourse is around Fishers Island, clockwise or counterclockwise, starting and finishing at the same point as chosen by the entrant.
- 6.2. Marks to be honored will be specified in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. All classes will be scored using their handicap formula for Time-on-Distance.
- 7.2. The boat with the Fastest Corrected Time from each class shall win that class.
- 7.3. The boat with the fastest Elapsed Time shall be deemed to be the overall "line honors" winner.
- 7.4. All entrants shall submit a log form to the Race Committee at mudheadRC@gmail.com upon completion of the racecourse.

8. PRIZES

8.1. Awards will be presented at the MRMSA Holiday Party and posted online.

9. WAIVER OF LIABILITY

- 9.1. Competitors participate in this regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 3, Decision to Race.
