NOTICE OF RACE (NOR)

Highlighted text new for 2024

1.0 The Tuesday Night Racing Series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) 2021-2024

2.0 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 Mono-hull boats 19ft or greater
- 2.2 Multi-hull boats of 16ft or greater
- 2.3 Skippers or Owners that are active members of the BCYC
- 2.4 Please Register and Pay through <u>www.yachtscoring.com</u>. Alternatively, payments may be made by check (payable to BCYC) and sent to the address below along with your application. Boats may enter by completing the entry form located on the BCYC website (<u>www.boynecityyachtclub.com/race-fleet</u>). You may download, complete, scan and email application to <u>augieengelhart@gmail.com</u> or mail to <u>Augie Engelhart 4480 Walloon Ct.</u> Boyne City, MI 49712 prior to the start of the applicable event(s). Boats will not be scored if the payment has not been received prior to the start of the event.

3.0 CLASSIFICATION

- 3.1 Class rules (MWPHRF) will apply.
- 3.2 Skippers or Owners must be current members of the BCYC.

4.0 **FEES**

- 4.1 \$250for both series (Spring, Summer); Discount of \$15 if you have a current US Sailing membership.
- 4.2 **\$130** per Series if not Registering for both Series at once. Discount of \$5 per series if you have a current US Sailing membership.
- 4.3 Registration for the BCYC Midsummer Sloman Pursuit Race is included with a combined Spring and Summer registration

5.0 SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Skipper's Meeting and Registration will be held on Tuesday April 30th (Trophy Room at Boyne Mountain -7pm)
- 5.2 Practice Race: Tuesday May 14th
- 5.3 Spring Series (May 21th July 16th)
- 5.4 Midsummer Sloman Pursuit Race July 23rd
- 5.5 Summer Series (July 30th Sept. 24th)
- 5.6 Each night of racing will consist of 1 race or as conditions allow
- 6.0 Sailing Instructions are available on the BCYC website (www.boynecityyachtclub.com) and yachtscoring.com

7.0 **COURSES**

- 7.1 Courses will consist of Windward/Leeward, Olympic style triangles or Distance Point to Point course, not to exceed 12 nautical miles and will vary due to wind conditions.
- 7.2 Windward legs of the course will typically be .75 mile in length, but may vary due to wind conditions.

8.0 SAFETY and SUPPORT BOATS

- 8.1 All boats shall have radio communications
- 8.2 Safety boats may not be available on a continual basis (as they are volunteers) and therefore each skipper is responsible for an alternative.
- 8.3 All boats shall comply with the current minimum equipment list required by the US Coast Guard and their class association.

9.0 **VENUE**

- 9.1 Racing will be in the vicinity of Boyne City on Lake Charlevoix
- 9.2 Post-race meeting place shall be at Boyne City Municipal Marina unless otherwise communicated by TEXT by the Race Fleet Captain prior to the start of the nightly race.

10.0 PRIZES and AWARDS

- 10.1 The top 3 boats, from each fleet, for each series, will be awarded a flag. Winners of flags will be presented at the BCYC Tuesday Race Celebration
- BOAT OF THE YEAR
 Boats/skippers that have shown exceptional sailing skills, improvement, enthusiasm, and/or have exemplified the Corinthian spirit of sailboat racing. To be determined by a vote at the end of season Race Celebration.

11.0 **INSURANCE**

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
