Notice of Race

North Star Sail Club, Harrison Township, MI, USA, is the organizing authority and will provide race management.

1. Rules

- **1.1** This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and as modified by the *Anchor Bay Yacht Racing Association 2024 Racing Handbook* (ABYRA Handbook), this notice of race, and the sailing instructions for this race.
- **1.2** The ABYRA Handbook will be posted on YachtScoring.com and available on NSSC website (NorthStarSail.org/Racing) no later than one week prior to the event.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This race is open to sailing vessels owned or chartered by individual members of clubs or associations that are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA, or US Sailing, and who have paid their race fees.
- **2.2** This race is open to JAM, asymmetrical, and spinnaker classes. Class splits will be posted at NSSC no later than 2 hours before the race. Five boats are required for a class.
- 2.3 Registration shall be submitted according to registration instructions on YachtScoring.com, also a link is available on the NSSC website (NorthStarSail.org/Racing).
- 2.4 Entry deadline is 48 hours prior to the race. Late entries will be accepted up to 2 hours before the race.

3. Fees

3.1 The race is <u>FREE</u> to ALL registered boats.

4. Schedule

- **4.1** The race is scheduled for June 8, 2024.
- **4.2** The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 1230 hours.
- **4.3** The intended schedule is to sail one race.

5. Measurement

5.1 If a boat does not have a current MWPHRF rating certificate, the RC will assign a temporary rating as described in the 2024 ABYRA Handbook.

6. Sailing Instructions

6.1 Sailing instructions for this race are included in the ABYRA Handbook under "General Sailing Instructions" and will be posted on YachtScoring.com no later than one week prior to the event.

7. Venue

7.1 The venue will be Anchor Bay, Lake St. Clair. The chart shows the approximate location of the racing area.

8. Courses

- **8.1** Available course configurations and visual signals are described in the 2023 ABYRA Handbook.
- **8.2** Available Course selection will be visually communicated to competitors prior to the warning signal.

| Course Description | Displayed Shape | Leave Marks |
|--|-----------------|-----------------|
| SPIN Class : twice around triangle formed by ABYRA buoys A, B, and CR1 plus one additional leg. | Red | To Port |
| JAM and Cruising classes: once around triangle formed by ABYRA buoys A, B, and CR1 plus one additional leg. | Green | To Starboard |



9. Scoring

9.1 Races will be scored using time-on-time for all classes.

10. Awards

10.1 Awards will be presented following the race at NSSC.

11. Disclaimer of Liability

11.1 Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.

12.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
