



## Docking Guide

Welcome to Cambridge and the Cambridge Yacht Club! If you plan on staying in Cambridge for the afternoon or overnight after the race, here is your docking guide:

After crossing the finishing line, **contact the CYC Fleet Captain, Stokes Liles, on Channel 71 or cell (917) 328-1094 to announce your arrival.** We will assist in directing you to your slip or let us know if you have alternative plans.

### Cambridge Yacht Club (CYC): (Max draft 7.5 ft)

- Slips are available on a first-come, first-served basis.
- Guaranteed reserved slip arrangements at CYC must be made through Dockwa. Indicate that you are a Navy Fall Race race participant.
- CYC volunteers will assist you with the docking.
- Please **wait** to enter the marine until directed to do so. There's limited space available to maneuver.

### Cambridge Municipal Yacht Basin (CMYB) (Max draft 7.5 ft)

- Adjacent to the Cambridge Yacht Club is the Cambridge Municipal Yacht Basin. Make your slip reservations through the CMYB website.
