Organizing Authority This regatta is organized under the authority of the Bay City Yacht Club and it will be sailed under the management of the organizing committee and the Race Committee.

Eligibility and Entry The Regatta is open to offshore multihulls between 22 and 45 feet in length with a GLMRA rating.

- Eligible boats enter by completing sign-up at www.yachtscoring.com. Entry deadline is Wednesday, August 21,2024.
- •Participants agree to abide by the rules and stipulations outlined in this Notice of Race and supplemental materials.

Fees and Registration All entries must submit a completed registration form by Wednesday, August 21, 2024. This year's entry fee is \$40.00, with the balance of the regatta costs provided by our sponsor, Gougeon Brothers, Inc. There is an additional fee of \$10.00 per night for tents and \$20.00 per night for trailers.

Racing Racing will be held on Saginaw Bay, Lake Huron near the mouth of the Saginaw River in Bay City, Michigan. Detailed buoy locations and race courses will be included in the Sailing Instructions available at registration or at the competitors' meeting.

The planned race schedule consists of two buoy races on Friday, a long-distance race on Saturday, and two buoy races on Sunday. No races will start after 1:30 PM on Sunday.

The entries will be divided into one or more fleets according to GLMRA ratings. Any division of the fleet will be announced at the competitors' meeting. All boats will also be scored as one fleet to determine the overall champion.

Rules Racing will be conducted in accordance with the following:

- The Series will be governed by rules as defined in current (2021-2024) The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- The Notice of Race and any amendments thereto;
- The Sailing Instructions and any amendments thereto. The Sailing Instructions may be modified at a competitors' meeting.

Ratings The Great Lakes Multihull Rating Association (GLMRA) time-on-time handicap

rating system will be used. A copy of the participant's GLMRA certificate must be sent with the registration information. Participants who fail to provide their current rating information with the registration form must accept the rating assigned by the local rating committee with no opportunity for appeal. There are no minimum or maximum crew requirements.

Scoring will be described in the *Sailing Instructions*.

Awards will be presented in the BCYC Clubhouse approximately two hours after the last boat finishes on Sunday.
