Event Headquarters and registration will be in the Spinnaker Room, located on the lower level of the club house next to the drysail area. 1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the 2009-2012 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the USSailing prescriptions; the 4/1/2008 revision of the T-10 Class One Design Rules and the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 The T-Ten Class Association North American Championship regulations (NACR) shall apply.

1.3 In the event of conflict between any of the above Rules and Regulations, Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall prevail.

2 ADVERTISING

2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the T-Ten one design class that meet the requirements of the T-Ten Class Association Rules.

3.2 All competitors shall comply with the eligibility requirements in accordance with the NACR Article 6 - Eligibility.

3.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing an online entry form or submitting a hard copy registration form via USPS or fax, providing proof of insurance, and paying an entry fee of \$350.00 no later than July 15, 2009.

3.4 Entries received after July 15, 2009 will require an additional late fee of \$150.00. No entries will be accepted after August 1, 2009.

3.5 A boat is considered registered when it has completed the following requirements;

- Payment of all fees
- Valid measurement certificate confirming that the yacht is still in compliance with the T-Ten One Design Rules and Amendments
- Copy of Insurance Policy evidencing required liability coverage
- Complete crew and alternates list
- Completed and signed sail measurement certificate within T-Ten One Design Rules and Amendments
- Completed and signed inventory of required equipment form.

Bow numbers will not be issued to a yacht until registration has been completed. Registration must be completed prior to 1730 Friday, August 7, 2009.

4 FEES

4.1 Required entry fee is \$350.00 per boat. Late entry fee will be an additional \$150.00.

4.2 Contestants unable to provide proof of current US Sailing membership must pay an additional \$40.00 fee.

4.3 Box lunches may be purchased at the time of registration. Cost per lunch will be \$6.50.

4.4 Social wrist band fee will be \$40.00 per person. One day event fee is \$15.00 and will be sold on site.

6 MEASUREMENTS

6.1 Boats shall comply with the one design requirements in accordance with the NACR Article 9.

6.2 Sails shall be measured in accordance with the NACR Article 8 – Sails.

6.3 A crew list and crew weight limit shall be instituted in accordance with NACR Article 7 – Persons On board.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after 1200 on August 6, 2009, at the registration desk.

8 VENUE

Racing area will be upon the open waters of Lake Erie, north of the Mentor Harbor Yachting Club.

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed shall be in accordance with NCACR Article 11 - Courses.

10 SCORING

The NACR Article – 10.1 shall be modified as per the Low-Point Scoring System of the RRS Appendix A. Each boat's series score will be the sum of the scores for all races. This changes RRS A2 "No score will be excluded".

11 HULL IDENTIFICATION

11.1 The organizing authority will supply hull identification stickers that shall be attached to each boat as directed by the organizing authority.

11.2 Sponsor or other regatta stickers may be required to be attached to each side of each boat as required by the organizing authority.

12 LAUNCHING

Launching and haul out services will be provided for all T-10's (other than boats within a 50-mile driving radius of Mentor Harbor) free of charge. Boats desiring to use the launching service are requested to make arrangements with MHYC's Harbor Master, Allan LeSuer @ 440-257-7214 prior to August 1, 2009. Boats within a 50-mile driving radius of MHYC may be launched and/or hauled for a nominal fee.

13 BERTHING

13.1 Docking and rafting space will be provided to all T-Ten NAC competitors free of charge from Wednesday August 5, 2009 through Wednesday August 12, 2009. Check in with the MHYC Harbor Master upon arrival for dock assignment.

13.2 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places in MHYC's basin From 1700 Friday August 7, 2009 until the morning of Tuesday August 11, 2009 unless prior written approval has been obtained from the organizing authority. The judges committee shall apply a 20% penalty for all races each day a boat is not docked or rafted in its assigned location the morning prior to the days' races.

14 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Competing boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with, and according to, the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

15 DIVING EQUIPMENT AND PLASTIC POOLS

Underwater breathing apparatus and plastic pools or their equivalent shall not be used around competing boats between the preparatory signal of the first race and the end of the regatta.

16 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

17 PRIZES

17.1 Perpetual trophies and awards will be given as follows:

- North American Championship Trophy
- Sparkman Stephens Performance Trophy
- Charlie Britton Memorial Award
- Elaine and Wes Pignolet Award

17.2 Prizes for first through fifth place overall and for first through fifth in each individual race will be awarded.

18 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

19 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with minimum coverage of \$300,000 per event or the equivalent.

20 GUEST PRIVILEGES AT MENTOR HARBOR YACHTING CLUB

MHYC does not accept cash. Purchases from MHYC must be via reciprocating yacht club charge, credit card, or house charge card. MHYC will provide a house charge card for any person providing a credit card for charges. Information will be available at registration.

21 BOX LUNCHES

Box lunches for the entire regatta must be ordered during registration. Cost per lunch will be \$6.50. Box lunch pick-up will be 0800 each morning of the regatta in the Spinnaker Room.

22 LOCAL ACCOMADATIONS

The NAC Committee has negotiated a limited block of rooms at the Residence Inn in Mentor, Ohio. See the NAC website for accommodation details.

23 MHYC HOUSE RULES

23.1 Hats are not to be worn in the club house23.2 After 1800 all men are required to wear collared shirts

23.3 Legal drinking age in Ohio is 21 years of age.
