The St. Thomas Yacht Club (STYC) is the Organizing Authority (O.A.) for this event.

1 Rules

1.1 The regatta will be governed by:

- a. The rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing. Rule 52 will not apply.
- b. The Caribbean Sailing Association (CSA) Rating Rule. Crew limitations for CSA classes will be in accordance with the CSA Rating Rule. CSA rating information can be found at www.caribbean-sailing.com
- c. The 2017 IRC Rule parts A, B & C. Rule 21.1.5 (d) will not apply.
- d. The ORC Rating Systems
- e. The Gunboat rating system for Gunboats and, the CSA Multihull Rule for other multihulls.

F The US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) for Near Shore and associated Appendices which will be on the race website. In the event of a conflict between these regulations and applicable class rules, the class rules shall apply.

1.2 The minimum number of crew aboard each boat shall be four. For yachts carrying a Regatta approved member of the press, this member of the press shall not be included in the crew Number, provided he/she does not contribute in any way (other than seated position to the yacht's competitive position).

2 Advertising

Boats may be required to display the event bow stickers and flags for the duration of the Regatta. Other advertising shall not conflict with this display.

3 Eligibility and Entry

3.1 The 2017 St. Thomas YC Round the Rocks Race is extending an invitation to CSA; IRC; Multihull; CSA Bareboat; and One Design classes with a minimum length of 24 feet. One design classes and groups of boats wishing to race level, will have separate classes or will be scored as a sub-class within a larger class at the discretion of the Regatta committee.

3.3 All crewmembers will be required to sign a waiver of liability and media release, which may be completed on-line.

6 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available on-line. Amendments to Sailing Instructions and other Notices will be available on-line. For email alerts to all postings please provide desired email recipient(s) with your online entry.

7 The Course

The course will be around the island of St. John in either a clockwise direction or a counter clockwise direction to be determined and announced before the start.

If conditions do not permit a race around St. John, alternative courses may be provided.

8 Penalty System

8.1 Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.

8.2 The Jury may impose a penalty other than disqualification for breaches of

non-part 2 rules. This changes rule 64.1.

8.3 Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

9 Scoring

One race will be sailed and scored in accordance with rule Appendix A.

10 Radio Communication

All boats shall carry a VHF radio capable of transmitting communications to and receiving communications from the Race Committee on channels 16, 71 and 72.

11 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded on the beach at St. Thomas Yacht Club commencing at 1830, Thursday March 23. Prizes will be awarded to first place, second place and third place in each class.

Unless an alternative course has been used, a perpetual trophy will be awarded for the best elapsed time sailing around St. John.

12 Disclaimer of Liability

Competitors agree to be bound by the Racing Rules of Sailing, by the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race. Competitors agree to take any and all responsibility for the sea worthiness of their yacht, the crew's ability and the safety equipment. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the regatta, relieving of any responsibility the St. Thomas Yacht Club and all persons involved in the organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behavior and dress of the yacht's crew, representatives and guests. Competitors shall be acquainted with Fundamental Rule 4: DECISION TO RACE: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone". In any case, competitors agree that the St. Thomas Yacht Club, the sponsors and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members or others, or for the loss of, or damage to any vessel or property. As part of the registration process, each individual participating crewmember will be required to sign a declaration accepting this disclaimer of liability.

13 Photographic and Media Rights

Competitors will be asked to grant the organizing authority the unrestricted right and permission to use the name and the image for any text, photograph or video footage of either themselves or the yacht they are sailing during the event to be published or broadcast in any media whatsoever (including but not limited to press and TV advertisements or internet), for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information; in this respect, competitors' names and any biographical material of themselves may also be used or reproduced in

any way known. As part of the registration process, each individual participating crewmember will be required to sign a declaration accepting this waiver of rights.
