NOTICE OF RACE

RULES

- **1.1** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2013 -2016*.
- **1.2** Racing rule(s) 44.1 will be changed as follows: two turns penalty is changed to one turn. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

2 ADVERTISING

- **2.1** Competitor advertising will be restricted as follows: A boat and her crew shall comply with ISAF Regulation 20, advertising code.
- **2.2** Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

3.1 A valid 2016 PHRFMA certificate is required. Waivers to the 2016 PHRFMA certificate requirement may be granted by the race committee upon written request, at the discretion of the committee.

4 FEES

4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Class Fee - All \$45.00 per boat

4.2 Other fees:

Saturday after racing:

Awards, Dinner and Dancing at Metedeconk River Yacht Club - \$40.00 per person

5 QUALIFYING SERIES AND FINAL SERIES

The regatta will consist of one distance race of approximately 18.5 nautical miles, or less. There will be a single start of all the classes with finishes taken for each class. The length of the course may change due to conditions.

6.4 The Harbor gun will be at 0830 hours and the scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1000 hours.

7 REGISTRATION

7.1 Advance registration is required. Deadline is Thursday, August 11, 2016. Registration can be done online at http://www.yachtscoring.com/emenu.cfm?eID=2913. Late registration may be accepted at the skippers meeting at the committees discretion and increased cost.

8 MEASUREMENTS

8.1 Each boat shall produce a valid 2016 PHRFMA rating certificate unless a waiver is obtained from the race committee.

9 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 The sailing instructions will be available after 0900 hours on August 12, 2016 at metedeconkriveryc.org. and at the Skippers' Meeting 1900 on August 12, 2016 at **Metedeconk River Yacht Club**

10 VENUE

10.1 Race headquarters will be Metedeconk River Yacht Club, Brick, NJ. The race course will be located in the Atlantic Ocean between Manasquan Inlet and Seaside Heights, New Jersey.

11 THE COURSE

11.1 This will be a distance race from a starting line near the Manasquan Inlet mile marker to a temporary mark or gate off of Mantoloking to another temporary mark placed off Seaside Heights, New Jersey, in the vicinity of the resting spot of the JetStar Roller Coaster following Hurricane Sandy. The rounding will be a port rounding with return passing of the Mantoloking Mark or Gate and to the finish line in the vicinity of Manasquan Inlet. There will be a single start of all the classes with finishes taken for each class. The length of the

12 PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 The penalties are as follows:

course may change due to conditions.

- **12.2** For all classes rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
- **12.3** Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

13 SCORING

- **13.1** The scoring system is as follows: The Low Point scoring system as provided in Appendix A of the RRS shall be used for this Regatta.
- 13.2 There will be no rain date.

14 SUPPORT BOATS

14.1 Support boats shall be marked with PATROL flag.

15 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

It will be the Race Committees prerogative to utilize radio transmissions on **Channel 6** to advise competitors of events. Otherwise, except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

16 PRIZES

- **16.1** Prizes will be given as follows: Each Fleet 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- **16.2** Awards will be given for Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker fleets. Other one design fleets may be formed and awards issued consistent with the above. At least three boats necessary to form a fleet.
- **16.3** Awards will be presented at the Awards Celebration following the regatta at Metedeconk River Yacht Club on August 13, 2016.

17 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

18 INSURANCE

18.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000 per incident or the equivalent.
