SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Amendment 1

- 14 Protests and requests for redress is amended as follows:
- Protest forms are available at the Protest desk located just outside of the Protest room on the second floor of the main Clubhouse. Protests and requests for redress or reopening shall be delivered there within the appropriate time limit.
- 14.3 Notices will be posted no later than 30 minutes after the protest time limit to inform competitors of hearings in which they are parties or named as witnesses. Hearings will be held in the protest room, located on the second floor of the main Clubhouse.
- Breaches of instructions 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25 and any breaches of class rules will not be grounds for a protest by a boat (NP). This changes RRS 60.1(a). Penalties for these breaches are at the discretion of the International Jury and may be less than a disqualification.
