

2010 Beneteau First 36.7 Summer One-Design Regatta Notice of Race

Organizing Authority

The Beneteau First 36.7 Summer One-Design Regatta is organized by the Regatta Committee of the Cleveland – Detroit Fleet of the North American Beneteau First 36.7 Class.

Rules

The race will be governed by rules as defined in the current Racing Rules of Sailing (2009-2012 RRS); the Sailing Instructions and any amendments.

Advertising

The Beneteau First 36.7 Class had been designated a Category A class under previous ISAF rules. In accordance with ISAF Regulation 20 Section 20.5.6, advertising for the Beneteau First 36.7 class is not permitted. Advertising for other classes is permitted to the extent that class rules allow.

Eligibility

Invitation to the Beneteau First 36.7 Summer One-Design Regatta is extended to members of the North American Beneteau First 36.7 Class, and to members of the North American C&C 35 Mark I class. Other classes may be included by the Organizing Authority.

Entry Requirements

Entries must be made on-line using the Official Entry Forms and be accompanied by a credit card paid entry fee. Entries must be received by August 6th, 2010.

Fees

The entry fee is \$45.00. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the committee. There is a \$15.00 Late Fee.

Courses

The Regatta will comprise of the DRYA Edison Boat Club Regatta on Friday evening, August 20, 2010 and up to four windward – leeward races on Saturday, August 21, 2010. The windward – leeward races on Saturday will take place in Lake St. Clair approximately 4.5 miles east of the Rear Range Light

Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available on the DRYA web site (www.drya.org) no later than August 19, 2010. The sailing instructions will be published separately for the Edison Yacht Club Regatta and the DRYA C-Course racing instructions will apply for the Saturday races.

Scoring

Each yacht's finish position will be scored for each race without throwout. Each boat's total score shall be the sum of her scores for all races. One race shall constitute a series.

Docking

Edison Boat Club has offered docking facilities for visiting yachts participating in the regatta. Additional docking may be available at either Bayview Yacht Club or Crescent Sail Yacht Club.

Trophies and Flags

Trophies and Flags will be left up to the individual classes participating in the event.
