NOTICE OF REGATTA

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined by *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012 (RRS)*.
- 1.2 Part 5 Section B is changed to provide for arbitration of protests of Part 2 rules.

2 ADVERTISING

- 2.1 No competitor advertising will be permitted
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority (OA)

3 ENTRIES & FEES

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Ideal 18 Class.
- 3.2 All eligible boats may enter on line at www.yachtscoring.com or by registering on approved entry forms available at www.larchmontyc.org and received by the Larchmont Yacht Club front desk not later than 1700, Friday September 8th 2010.
- 3.3 All entries not submitted on line shall be mailed to the Larchmont Yacht Club, 1 Woodbine Ave., Larchmont, NY 10538. Telephone: 914-834-2440. Faxed entries will be accepted only with a valid signature for credit card authorization. Fax: 914-468-7751.
- 3.4 The entry fee for this regatta is \$150.00 which includes continental breakfast Saturday and Sunday and dinner for two people Saturday evening. Additional dinner tickets are \$30.00 each. A late fee of \$50.00 will be added to any entries received after September 8, 2010.

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 Sailing instructions will be available at the registration table, located on the porch of the Larchmont Yacht Club on Friday September 17th 2010 or on the website at: www.larchmontyc.org.

5 SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

6 COURSES

Courses will be a triangle, windward-leeward or Harry Anderson as described in the sailing instructions.

7 RACE AREA

The racing area will be in the waters off the breakwater of Larchmont Harbor.

8 SCORING

8.1 Three (3) completed races will constitute a series.

8.2 The Race Committee intends to run multiple races. If fewer than 6 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. If 6 or more races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score subject to rule 90.3(b).

9 HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

Boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee

10 PRIZES

10.1 Prizes will be awarded following the conclusion of racing on Sunday, September 19th.

10.2 Prizes will be awarded for first, second and third place finishers.

11 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$300,000 per event or equivalent

12 CHARTER BOATS

A limited number of boats may be available for charter, if interested contact Lincoln White at: sailingdirector@larchmontyc.org. Charter fee for this event is \$200.00

13 CONDUCT AND RESPONSIBILITY

13.1 The skipper/owner shall be responsible for all actions of his or her crew or guests. In the event of a breach of conduct, sportsmanship, destruction of property, or failure to comply with the request of any race officer, committee member or agent of the Larchmont Yacht Club, the skipper/owner will be held responsible and his/her boat shall be subject to protest and disqualification.

13.2 The Larchmont Yacht Club is not responsible and will not accept any liability for bodily injury, death or property damage suffered from any cause. Each participant, including skipper and crew, participates in the regatta entirely at his/her own risk and waives any and all claims, including those arising from negligence or lack of due care, which he/she may have against the Larchmont Yacht Club, its regatta committee, and its officers, trustees, committee members, members, agents, or employees. Responsibility for

evaluating the wind, sea and weather conditions rests with each participant as does responsibility for the safe condition of the boat, including safety equipment and rigging and for deciding when to wear life jackets. Patrol boats or other assistance will not likely be available. Assistance, if any, from the regatta committee or other Larchmont Yacht Club vessels, or other patrol boats, from any personnel manning them, is entirely at the risk of the participant.
