# 3. ELIGIBILIT Y AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The Sag Harbor Cup is open to all sailboats with a valid 2017 ELI-PHRF Certificate for Div 1 & 2 (spinnaker), & Div 3 (non-spinnaker). Division 4 (performance cruising class) will be assigned local PHRF ratings from the RC.
- 3.2 To get an ELI-PHRF Certificate go to www.ELISAILING.ORG and follow the links on the right hand column.

# 4. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

4.1 Saturday June 3rd, 2017

#### 5. <u>ENTRY FEES</u> – Due by 5pm on Thursday, June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017.

5.1 \$70.00 entry fee includes two free tokens for food (\$40.00 Tax Deductible). Additional tokens available on the registration page, prepaid 4 for \$15.00 or \$5.00 each at the door.
All registration and payment needs to be done directly through the Sag Harbor Cup Yacht Scoring Page: YACHTSCORING SAG CUP.

#### 6. THE COURSE

- 6.1 The course for each division will be selected by the Race Committee from the list of courses contained in the sailing instructions. Courses will be announced (VHF Channel 72) and posted by the RC on station prior to any start sequence. The race will be run in Northwest Harbor, Shelter Island Sound, and Noyack Bay, Little Peconic Bay, or some variation of those locations.
- 6.2 The race will **START** in Noyack Bay and will **FINISH** either near Majors Point or off the Sag Harbor Breakwater, depending on divisions and chosen courses.

#### 7. SCORING

7.1 All classes will be scored using time on time.

#### 8. PRIZES

8.1 Trophies will be awarded for first, second and third in all divisions with at least 4 boats entered. Various trophy categories will be awarded including Club Team, Junior, Female Helmswoman, and more.

#### 9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at the **YACHTSCORING SAG CUP** website, and will be available from the Race Committee Boat prior to the regatta Entrants will be notified by email of any changes to the Sailing Instructions by 6pm prior to the day of the race, otherwise will be notified by the Race Committee Boat on the day of the Race.
