Eligibility: This race is open to sail yachts owned or chartered by individual members of clubs or associations which are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA, or US Sailing, and who have paid their race fees.

Registration: This race is FREE to ALL registered boats. Registration shall be submitted according to registration instructions on YachtScoring.com (also available through the NSSC web site NorthStarSail.org/Racing). Completed entry forms shall be received by 1200 on the day prior to the event. Late entries will be accepted and will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

Classes: JAM, Asymmetrical, and Spinnaker classes. Class splits will be posted at NSSC clubhouse no later than 2 hours before the race. Five boats are required for a class.

Schedule: The race is scheduled for June 25, 2017. The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 1230.

Ratings: If a boat does not have a current DRYA rating certificate, the RC will assign a temporary rating as described in the ABYRA Handbook.


Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be posted on YachtScoring.com (also available through the NSSC web site NorthStarSail.org/Racing) no later than one week prior to the event. Changes to the Sailing Instructions will be posted by 1000 on the day of the race. It is the responsibility of each competitor to check the online notice board for notices.


Course: One of two courses will be used. The Lake Course will be on Lake St. Clair from the Clinton River buoy CR to government buoy 1PH, which is to be left to starboard, then to St. Clair Light, which is to be left to starboard, then to LSSC buoy L off of St. Clair Shores, which is to be left to starboard, then to 1PH, which is to be left to port, then to the finish between CR and the committee boat. The direction of the course between 1PH, St. Clair Light, and LSSC buoy L may be reversed depending on wind direction. Mark locations are illustrated in this Notice of Race. The Bay Course will be on Anchor Bay in Lake St. Clair from the Clinton River buoy CR to ABYRA buoy C, which is to be left to starboard, then to government buoy 1FH, which is to be left to port, then to ABYRA buoy C, which is to be left to port, then to the finish between CR and the committee boat. The course will be announced on the water by the race committee.

Scoring: Races will be scored using time-on-time over PHRF for classes and division overall.

Awards: Overall and class awards will be presented following the races.
