NOTICE OF RACE

The Organizing Authority is the Northern Lake George Yacht Club in conjunction with the International Star Class Yacht Racing Association (ISCYRA). The host fleet is the Northern Lake George Star Fleet.



RULES

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS). The notation '[DP]' in a rule in this Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Entries shall be submitted on the Official Online Entry Form not later than July 21, 2017 to the Northern Lake George Yacht Club. Competitors MAY NOT launch boat until inspected by the Lake George Park Commission. Boats coming from a body of water other than Lake George must wash boat with soap and water, get inspected and receive the vessel inspection control seal (VICS). No boat will be allowed to launch without an intact VICS Seal. When launching at NLGYC, tags will be cut and documented in journal at hoist.

NLGYC will have Lake George Park Commission steward at the yacht club Friday July 28th, to wash, inspect and tag at club for convenience. If competitors would like to launch early and practice, locations to get boats washed, inspected and tagged are provided below;

- Norowal Marina in Bolton (just south of yacht club off 9N)

- Rogers Rock (closest to yacht club, just north off 9N)

HOISTING, BERTHING and TRAILER STORAGE

The option is up to the competitor whether they would like to dry sail or leave the boat in the water overnight. If you plan on leaving the boat in the water, please bring your own anchor and mooring. Trailer parking will be provided at the yacht club. As this regatta falls between NYS/districts (July 21-23) and the Sunapee Open (Aug 4-6), we are allowing people to leave boats in parking lot here as needed. Please notify Lauren Barth by July 14th if you wish to leave boat in our parking lot prior to or after our regatta.

INSURANCE

Each boat shall hold adequate insurance including third-party liability insurance, and it is the owner or owners' representative's sole and inescapable responsibility to ensure that the insurance is in place and is adequate prior to participating in this event.

WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INJURY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. Sailing is an activity that has an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the Regatta entirely at their own risk.

By participating in this event, each competitor (owners, skippers, and crews) agrees to release the race organizers and all persons and groups listed above from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
