1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2. The Class Rules in effect are the rules of PHRF handicap, International One-Design, J-70, Ensign and Watch Hill classes, except as modified by the sailing instructions.
- 1.3. Participants on boats without lifelines shall wear life jackets while racing.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. This regatta is open to all yachts with a valid PHRF certificate on file with ECSA, and one design classes for International One Design, J-70, Watch Hill 15 and Ensign Classes, and by invitation.
- 2.2. There will be Spinnaker and Non Spinnaker classes.
- 2.3. Entrants shall register to race and purchase party tickets online through the Yacht Scoring link available at www.fiyc.net.

3. FEES and DEADLINES

- 3.1. The entry fee is \$60 per boat for US Sailing Members, \$80 for non members.
- 3.2. Party tickets are available in advance for \$20 / adult and \$15 / child.
- 3.3. Party tickets at the door are \$30 /adult and \$15 / child.
- 3.4. Registration deadline is Thursday, August 31st at 2330.

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Class assignments will be made by the Race Committee on Friday, September 1st.
- 4.2. First warning is scheduled at 1000 on Saturday, September 2, 2017.
- 4.3. One race is scheduled. There are no exclusions.
- 4.4. Entertainment at FIYC begins immediately following the race.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. The Sailing Instructions will be available on line after Monday, August 28, 2017.
- 5.2. Scratch Sheets will be posted on line on Friday, September 1st.

6. THE COURSES

- 6.1. All classes will start and finish just outside West Harbor, Fishers Island.
- 6.2. The race will be around Fishers Island. Course descriptions will be in the Sailing Instructions.

7. SCORING

- 7.1. PHRF classes will be handicapped using the Time on Time method.
- 7.2. One design classes will be scored first to finish and also be scored with Time on Time method only to determine the Fasted Corrected Time for all boats.

8. AWARDS

- 8.1. Commodore David F. Harris Trophy for 1st FIYC boat entered into a PHRF class.
- 8.2. First, Second and Third place trophies in every class.
- 8.3. Island Cup for combined results from FIYC, Mason's Island YC and Ram Island YC races.
- 8.4. Wilkinson Trophy for Fasted Corrected Time in fleet.
