LAUNCHING

SEMINOLE RAMP: Despite Seminole ramp sustained hurricane damages, the City of Miami guaranteed the usage and it will be open for the A-Cat Class and the Flying Tigers.

CRANES: We contacted Shake A Leg and US Sailing Center and asked for their availability. Shake-A-Leg does not want to commit with us as a group, but they may accommodate you individually. US Sailing Center is accepting reservations with the following terms: *Boats must stage at Regatta Park (see map) and will be allowed to go to USSC as directed by MSW personnel; this is due to lack of maneuvering space at the facility. Cranes are available once the Star Class boats are all in and before they return from their regatta.* USSC cost is \$30.00 + tax each way. Please send us a request form.

BERTHING

DINNER KEY MARINA: The Marina will provide us with berthing space for the Melges 24 and the Flying Tiger + any support boats (please register your boat with us). A request form can be found in the Document section of our event on YachtScoring. Berthing location is shown on Map. The discounted City fee is \$60.00 + tax from Wednesday to Sunday (4 nights maximum).
