Notice of Race

North Star Sail Club, Harrison Township, MI, USA, is the organizing authority.

1. Rules

1.1. This race will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) and as modified by the *Anchor Bay Yacht Racing Association 2018 Racing Handbook* (ABYRA Handbook), this notice of race, and the sailing instructions for this race series.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. This race is open to sail yachts owned or chartered by individual members of clubs or associations that are members in good standing of ABYRA, DRYA, or US Sailing, and who have paid their race fees.
- 2.2. In the event that the registered skipper is unable to be on board, he or she is allowed to have a duly insured alternate skipper to represent him or her in up to two (2) races.
- 2.3. This race is open to JAM, asymmetrical, and spinnaker classes. Class splits will be posted at NSSC clubhouse no later than 2 hours before the race. Five boats are required for a class.
- 2.4. All registered boats are responsible for one race committee duty per the rules described in the ABYRA Handbook. The Race Committee sign up can be found on at NorthStarSail.org/Racing.
- 2.5. Registration shall be submitted according to registration instructions on YachtScoring.com (also available through the NSSC website NorthStarSail.org/Racing). Completed entry forms shall be received by 1200 on the day prior to the event.
- 2.6. Each series will have a separate registration on Yacht Scoring.
- 2.7. Late entries will be accepted and will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

3. Fees

3.1. The entry fee is \$55.00 per series.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. Spring Series: May 11, 18, 25, June 8, 15, 22.
- 4.2. Summer Series: July 27, August 3, 17, 24, September 7, 14.
- 4.3. The warning signal for the first start is scheduled for 1900.

5. Measurement

5.1. If a boat does not have a current DRYA rating certificate, the RC will assign a temporary rating as described in the ABYRA Handbook.

6. Sailing Instructions

- 6.1. Sailing instructions for this series are included in the ABYRA Handbook under "General Sailing Instructions" and in the North Star Sail Club section that contains special notices.
- 6.2. The ABYRA Handbook will be posted on YachtScoring.com (also available through the NSSC website NorthStarSail.org/Racing) no later than one week prior to the event.

7. Venue

7.1. The venue will be Anchor Bay, Lake St. Clair. The chart shows the approximate location of the racing area.

8. Courses


- 8.1. Available course configurations and visual signals are described in the ABYRA Handbook.
- 8.2. Course selection will be visually communicated to competitors prior to the warning signal.

9. Scoring

- 9.1. Races will be scored using time-on-time over PHRF for classes and division overall.
- 9.2. See the ABYRA Handbook for series scoring rules.

10. Awards

10.1. Results will be presented at NSSC after each race. Spring awards will be presented after the first race of Summer series. Summer and Season awards will be presented at the ABYRA Haul Out Party.



11. Disclaimer of Liability

11.1. Competitors participate in the race entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the race.

12. Insurance

12.1. Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
