SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

1.1 Breakwater Yacht Club, Sag Harbor, NY

2. RULES

- 2.1 Racing will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including US Sailing Prescriptions and the General Conditions and Rules of ELIYA (www.elisailing.org) except as altered by these Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2 US Sailing Racing Rule 52 is modified so that a Brenta 38 may use hydraulics for their mainsail only.

3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

3.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the regatta website, <u>www.SagHarborCup.org</u>.

4 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 4.1 Any change to the Sailing Instructions will be posted on the regatta web site www.SagHarborCup.org before 1800 hours on the day prior to racing.
- 4.2 Any changes to the Sailing Instructions after 1800 hours on the day prior to racing will be made available from the Race Committee (RC) boat or an auxiliary RC boat.

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 5.1 Signals made ashore will be displayed at Breakwater Yacht Club at 0900 hours and regatta web site www.SagHarborCup.org of the day of racing and announced on VHF 72.
- 5.2 When flag N is over flag A the race will be abandoned and rescheduled for Sunday, June 3rd.

6 SCHEDULE

Saturday, June 2nd, 2018 1300 hours First sound signal 1700 hours Awards Party

7 TIME

7.1 The RC will be using a GPS as the official timepiece.

8 TIME LIMIT

8.1 All boats must finish within 5 hours of their start, within 2 hours of the first finishing boat in their division or whichever comes first.

9 RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

- 9.1 The RC will broadcast and receive communications on VHF 72.
- 9.2 All competitors shall make every effort to monitor VHF 72.

CHECK IN 10

10.1 Boats must sail by the RC boat and hail their sail number and boat name prior to the start or do the same on VHF 72. RC will acknowledge boats as they check in.

11

- **START** The race will **START** in Noyack Bay. 11.1
- 11.2 The starting line will be between a yellow flag on the RC Boat and the ball at the port end of the line.
- 11.3 The start will be in accordance with Rule 26.

12 STARTING ORDER

Additional starts may be added for one design classes after entry deadline.

12.1 Division 3 (Non-spinnaker) First Start

Division 2 (Spinnaker, PHRF 106 and more)

Start 5 minutes after Div. 3's start.

Division 4 (One-Design/Etchells)

Start 5 minutes after Div. 2's start.

Division 1 (Spinnaker, PHRF 105 and less)

Start 5 minutes after Div. 4's start.

13 **FINISH**

- 13.1 The FINISH will be near Majors Point in Shelter Island Sound, between a yellow flag on the RC Boat and the ball at the port end of the line.
- 14 **MARKS** – Positions are approximate.

15 **COURSES**

- 15.1 The Course Board will be displayed on the starboard side of the RC Boat.
- 15.2 The Race Committee may elect to have a Windward Mark (WM) as the first mark of the course. If so the Course Board will display the Course Name followed by "WM". If "WM" is circled it shall be left to Starboard, otherwise it shall be left to Port.
- 15.3 For all courses, when going between N8 and either G15 or N14T, pass north of C"S" in the "North Channel" (south of Mashomack Point) and don't use the "South Channel" (by R "10A").
- 15.4 All government marks must be honored except during use as a mark of the course, and except N14T

15.5 The Course(s) will be chosen from the following courses:

<u>Course 3 "Crow Shoal"</u> – R16(s) - G15(s) - N14T(p) - N8(p) - N14C(p) - N8(s) - N14T(s) – Finish

<u>Course 4 "Ram's Head"</u> – R16(s) - G15(s) - N14T(p) - N8(p) - MoaR(p) - N8(s) - N14T(s) – Finish

<u>Course 5 "Ram's Head-longer"</u> - R16(s) - G15(s) - N14T(p) - N8(p) - MoaR(s) - C1(s) - MoaR(s) - C1(s) - N8(s) - N14T(s) - Finish

<u>Course 7 "Little Peconic"</u> -R16(p) - N14P(p) - R18(p) - N14P(p) - R18(p) - G17(s) - R16(p) - G15(s) - N14T(p) - Finish

Course 8 "Robin's Island" – R16(p) - N14P(p) - G17(p) - R18(p) - R20(p) - R18(s) - G17(s) - R16(p) - G15(s) - N14T(p) – Finish

- 16 **SCORING**
- 16.1 All yachts will be scored using Time on Time. Time Correction Factor (TCF)=600/(480+PHRF).
- 17 PROTESTS
- 17.1 Protest time limit is 1 hour after the RC boat has docked at Breakwater Yacht Club.
- 17.2 Protest forms must be received by the race committee at Breakwater Yacht Club clubhouse.
- 18 **RETIREMENT**
- 18.1 All vessels that retire from the race must call in to the RC with their intentions.
- 19 PRIZES
- 19.1 Trophies will be awarded to first, second and third place in each division. Specialty trophies will be at the after party.
- 20 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY
- 20.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See US Racing rule 4, "Decision to Race". The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 21 INSURANCE
- 21.1 Each Participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance.
