1. Black group classes

- (a) The rating bands for the three IRC classes (IRC 1, 2 and 3) are as shown below.
- (b) There will be a separate class for the J/111, which will sail with IRC1 but on a level rated basis and in compliance with their class rules.
- (c) There will be two additional classes, for HP30s and J/88s. Boats in these classes shall comply with their class rules. They will start together, with the IRC 2 class.
- (d) The Black Group table in SI 6.0 is amended to the following:
