

Sailing Instructions EGYC Annual Regatta Saturday July 14, 2018

1.0 RULES

The East Greenwich Yacht Club Annual Race will be governed by the 2017-2020 The Racing Rules of Sailing, The International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea, these sailing instructions, the Notice of Race and any amendments. This is a "club" event with other Yacht Club or Sailing Association members invited to participate. All yachts, in addition to all federally required equipment, shall have a VHF radio aboard and shall keep radio energized on the Race Committee working channel VHF channel 69 from her warning signal until her "finish". Additionally, the Race Committee **shall** continuously monitor VHF Ch. 13, "Ship to Ship". The Narragansett Bay race area, with its East and West passages and approaches to Providence and Fall River, are considered a "restricted channel" for commercial traffic and vessels in the navigation channel, restricted in their ability to maneuver. Sailors must comply with the International COLREGS when in such proximity to commercial or privileged marine traffic. Yachts who obstruct the safe passage of commercial traffic are subject to protest under The Racing Rules of Sailing. A violation under this instruction shall be considered a violation of rule 2. The Race Committee or Protest Committee, upon the report of information or observation of an incident **shall** protest a yacht. This is in addition to the requirements of rule 60.2 (a) and the preamble to Part 2.

2.0 **NOTICES**

- 2.1 Fleet Radio Channel The East Greenwich Yacht Club Annual Regatta official FLEET CHANNEL is VHF channel 69.
- 2.2 Notices to competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board located on the east deck of the East Greenwich Yacht Club.

3.0 AMENDMENTS

Amendments to the Sailing Instructions will be posted before 0900 the day of the race, on the Official Notice Board on the east deck of the East Greenwich Yacht Club. The Race Committee will endeavor to announce posted amendments via VHF channel 69 at 1130 hours. All yachts shall monitor channel 69 during the race day.

4.0 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

- 4.1 Signals ashore shall be made aboard the designated Race Committee Boat, docked at East Greenwich Yacht Club.
- 4.2 Code Flag LIMA will signify posting of a notice or amendment.

5.0 SCHEDULE OF RACES

In accordance with date and times listed in the Notice of Race.

6.0 RACING AREA

Yachts will rendezvous in the area 1 NM south of G'1' Fl G 2.5s Round Rock.

7.0 **COURSES**

- 7.1 The Race Committee will announce over the radio whether the Long, Medium or the Short course will be used.
- 7.2 The Race committee will post on a whiteboard on the Race Committee Boat the course to be used by each class
- 7.3 The starting time for each yacht will be based on the yacht's rating and the length of the course. The appendixes 1 9 will be used for each yacht's starting time. The appendixes will be posted 24 hours before the start of race.

7.4 Spinnaker Class

7.4(a) Spinnaker Class - Long Course: (Appendix #1) 16.37 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, X - SPECIAL Mark Orange Inflatable (approx. .25 nm north of FL 5 Priv Tower *Plum Beach Lighthouse*) to Port, G "3" N of Conanicut Island to Starboard, R'2' North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, R'8' Patience Island to Port, to finish.

7.4(b) Spinnaker Class - Medium Course: (Appendix #1) 14.08 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, X - SPECIAL Mark Orange Inflatable (approx. .25 nm north of FL 5 Priv Tower *Plum Beach Lighthouse*) to Port, G "3" N of Conanicut Island to Starboard, R'2' North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, to finish.

7.4 (c) Spinnaker Class - Short Course: (Appendix #1) 9.37 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, R'2' North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, to finish.

7.5 Non-Spinnaker

7.5(a) Non-Spinnaker - Long Course: (Appendix #) 14.29 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, SPECIAL Mark Yellow Inflatable at Halfway Ledge (approx. .5 nm East of Fox Island) to Port, G "3" N of Conanicut Island to Starboard, R'2' Fl R 4s Bell North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, R'8' Patience Island to Port, to finish.

7.5(b) Non-Spinnaker - Medium Course: (Appendix #) 12.00 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, SPECIAL Mark Yellow Inflatable at Halfway Ledge (approx. .5 nm East of Fox Island) to Port, G "3" Northwest Conanicut Island to Starboard, R'2' Fl R 4s Bell North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, to finish.

7.5 (c) Non-Spinnaker - Short Course: (Appendix #) 9.37 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, R'2' Fl R 4s Bell North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, to finish.

7.6 Family Class

7.6 (a) Family Class - Long Course: (Appendix #1) 11.66 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, R'2' Fl R 4s Bell North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, R'8' Patience Island to Port, to finish.

7.6 (b) Family Class - Medium Course: (Appendix #1) 9.37 NM

From the start to G'7' Quonset Pt to Port, R'2' Fl R 4s Bell North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, to finish.

7.6 (c) Family Class - Short Course: (Appendix #1) 8.56 NM

From the start to R "12" FI R 4S Quonset Pt to Port, R'2' FI R 4s Bell North East of Conanicut Pt. to Port, G'1' Despair Island to Port, to finish.

8.0 The Start

- 8.1 The starting line shall be between the orange flag on the Committee Boat and the nearby inflatable mark.
- 8.2 The race shall be started using successive start signals, in accordance with starting times listed in the Appendixes. Red flag and HORN at one minute intervals per assigned time. Each signal will be lowered 30 seconds before the next signal. Note: all starts will be on Red flag. **THIS CHANGES RRS 26**

General warning signal 1200 hrs. - Blue flag and gun

General prep signal 1205 hrs. - 'P' flag and gun

First Start 1210 hrs. - Red flag and horn

- 8.3 The RC is allowed to postpone that start by a period of either 15, 30, 45 or 60 minutes. If the race is postponed, the time of postponement in minutes is added to each yacht's starting time.
- 8.4 5 minutes before each yacht's starting time will be considered that yacht's Preparatory signal. She shall not use her engine after her Preparatory signal. Yachts shall keep clear of the starting area until 5 minutes before their respective starting signal.
- 8.5 TIME OF SIGNALS: General warning signal and each successive signal will be based on GPS time.
- 8.6 The Race Committee will attempt to notify yachts of their starting time. While all efforts will be made to inform all competitors of the starting order, failure of a yacht to hear the announcement will not be grounds for protest.

9.0 **RECALLS**

Individual recalls will be in accordance with the Racing Rules of Sailing.

10.0 THE FINISH

10.1 The finish line for all courses shall be between the orange flag on the Committee Boat and the location in the area 1 nm south of G'1' Fl G 2.5s Round Rock. Yachts must finish between the mark and the boat in the

direction from the last turning mark.

11.0 TIME LIMIT

- 11.1 The first boat to finish must do so by 1700, (or plus added time due to postponement). The Committee Boat will leave station at 1830 or (or plus added time due to postponement). Any yachts finishing after the RC leaves station, must record their own time.
- 11.2 Any yacht retiring the race prior to 1830 hrs. must notify the EGYC Race Committee at EGYC 465-7245 or VHF channel 69.

12.0 **PROTESTS**

- 12.1 In addition to the requirements of rule 61.0, protesting yachts must notify the Race Committee of their intention to protest immediately after finishing the race.
- 12.2 Protests shall be written and submitted to the Jury Chairman at the East Greenwich Yacht Club within one hour of the Race Committee signal boat docking.
- 12.3 Notice of protests will be posted on the Official Notice Board on the south west deck of the East Greenwich Yacht Club.
- 12.4 Protests will be heard Saturday July 16, 2016, 1 1/2 hours after the Race Committee signal boat docks, at the East Greenwich Yacht Club.

13.0 PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded at EGYC during the dinner following the race.

14.0 DISPOSAL OF TRASH

Yachts discharging trash overboard shall be disqualified from the race.

15.0 LIABILITY WAIVER

All eligible yachts must have filed the enclosed liability waiver with the organizing authority by the start of the race to qualify for the finish of this race.
